

1 2-28-07: I received a letter in the mail today from Willem "Bill" Tazelaar's Attorney, Patrick Ball. In this  
2 letter, Ball request that members of the Oakland County Child Killer Task Force, cease contact with his  
3 client, Bill Tazelaar, immediately. Attorney Ball requests that any communication regarding his client go  
4 through him from here forward. Hand written at the end of this letter was a note indicating that he  
5 would call me next week.

6 3-1-07: \*\*\* (Info from Livonia Dispatcher about a blue Gremlin, on the night, but prior to Tim  
7 King's body being found in Livonia) \*\*\* I received a phone call today from a retired Livonia Police  
8 Dispatcher named Kay Gallagher. She was working the afternoon shift as a dispatcher the evening  
9 Timothy King's body was discovered on Gill Rd. in Livonia. During the conversation, she indicated that  
10 there was something that always bothered her that evening and she wanted to relay the information to  
11 me. She said in the early evening hours, the night his body was found, she received a call from the pay  
12 phone at Plymouth & Merriman in Livonia (Daly's Restaurant). The caller told Kay that he was following  
13 a blue Gremlin west bound on Plymouth Rd. and he (the caller) pulled into "Daly's" to use the phone  
14 and call the police. The caller said that they observed a white male subject, with dark hair driving the  
15 Gremlin and there was a young boy with a red jacket on in the passenger side. Kay told me that the  
16 caller thought the Gremlin continued westbound on Plymouth Rd. Kay said that there was information  
17 from the media that a blue Gremlin was possibly involved in the abduction and that Timothy King was  
18 last seen wearing a red jacket. Kay said that she put the info out to the south-end Livonia scout cars,  
19 who searched for but never located the Gremlin.

20 Kay stated that between approximately 9:00 PM -10:00 PM that same evening, 2-3 hours later, she  
21 received another call from a different person, stating that they just observed a blue Gremlin, northbound  
22 on Newburgh Rd. from Plymouth Rd. The caller described the occupants as being an adult white male,  
23 with dark hair, driving and a young white male on the passenger side with a red jacket on. This caller  
24 told Kay that the young boy was slumped over on the passenger side like he was sleeping. Kay told  
25 me that she put this info out to the Livonia scout cars and the Gremlin was not located.

26 She told me that after her shift that night, she found out that Timothy King's body was discovered on  
27 Gill Rd. south of 8 Mile Rd. in Livonia prior to midnight and that he was wearing his red Hockey jacket.  
28 She told me she was sick about it and began replaying those two calls in her head. She stated that  
29 based on her experience as a dispatcher and the amount of calls she has answered she believed these  
30 to be legitimate calls, stating that if we had cellphones back then, they would have been caught.

31 I asked her how runs like that were documented in 1977. She said she believed that dispatch cards  
32 were used, but would be surprised if they still existed. She said she might have jotted some notes on  
33 those cards. I called Sgt. Wes McKee of our records section and he is going to try to locate those  
34 cards for me.

35 3-5-07: I gave Prosecutor Rob Moran a copy of the written Cooperation agreement today, for Ted  
36 Lamborgine's Attorney. This agreement was drafted by the Assistant United States Attorney, Jennifer  
37 Gorland, Chief of the General Crimed Unit, U.S. Department of Justice, Eastern District.

38 3-6-07: I received a call today from Patrick Ball (Willem Tazelaar's Attorney). He didn't say that  
39 Willem's not going to take the polygraph; just that Willem had a few more questions about it. I  
40 explained our position and our obligation to conduct a follow-up investigation into Willem Tazelaar due  
41 to his brothers admitted involvement in pedophilia and knowing Ted Lamborgine, Titus Jones ("Duffy")  
42 & their possible connection to the OCCK case. I read the four questions to Mr. Ball, that Willem will be  
43 asked on the polygraph. Mr. Ball said that he would talk to Willem and call me back.

44 3-6-07: \*\*\* ( Witness see's Gremlin @ 8 & Gill Rd. 10:45pm 3-22-77) \*\*\* Today while I was going  
45 through a report that D/Sgt. Varajon (Livonia PD) had written in 1977, related to Livonia investigation  
46 into the Timothy King Murder, I observed a "B.O.L." (Be On the Lookout) put out to the patrol officers in  
47 Livonia on March 30<sup>th</sup> 1977. This teletype stated that on March 22, 1977 a witness observed a Blue  
48 Gremlin with a green "Hockey Stripe" come eastbound on 8 Mile Rd. at approximately 10:45 PM. The  
49 witness observed this Gremlin to pass Gill Rd., do a "U-Turn" back west, and make a left turn, south  
50 onto Gill Rd. The witness stated that a few minutes later they observed this vehicle come back north

1 on Gill to 8 Mile Rd. and go eastbound. The witness described the occupants as being two white  
2 males, one matching the composite and the other to have a small to medium "Afro." This information,  
3 if true, matches the information from the Livonia Dispatcher about the Gremlin last seen by the second  
4 caller seeing the Gremlin northbound on Newburgh from Plymouth Rd. These calls were prior to the  
5 discovery of Timothy King's body in Livonia. At 10:45 PM, this witness said they observed the Gremlin  
6 coming eastbound towards Gill Rd. This would mean that the Gremlin came from Newburgh rd., which  
7 is the next main road west of Gill Rd. \*\*\* So there is a call from a witness who sees the Gremlin  
8 westbound on Plymouth Rd. from Merriman at approx. 6-7 PM. Another call at approx. 8-9 PM, they  
9 see the Gremlin northbound on Newburgh from Plymouth Rd. Third witness at 10:45 PM, sees the  
10 Gremlin coming eastbound on 8 Mile Rd. from Newburgh. \*\*\* (See Livonia Det. Varajon's file from  
11 1977, for a copy of this memo) \*\*\*

12 3-6-07: Today I was reading the Livonia file from the 1977 Murder investigation of Timothy King, and  
13 observed a transcript from a taped interview conducted by detectives with Medical Examiner, Warner  
14 Spitz. This interview was about the autopsy of Timothy King. In this transcript, Spitz stated that he did  
15 not believe that the King boy was smothered with a hand, stating that there would have been more  
16 trauma to his face, specifically his lips and mouth area. Spitz gave an opinion that he believed a pillow  
17 of some sort might have been used stating that he may have been asleep, indicating no signs of a  
18 struggle. This information could match what [redacted] said, when he described how when he was  
19 raped in the house in Oakland County, his face have been pushed into the cushions of the sofa and he  
20 could not breathe. [redacted] said that he thought he was going to die that time, stating that he was  
21 gasping for air while they raped him rectally. [redacted] said that Ted Lamborgine was involved in this rape.  
22 \*\*\* (See E-Mail from [redacted] about this incident for detail)

23 3-7-07: Today, we met with Special Agent Phil Torsney (FBI) from the Cleveland Office to compare  
24 notes with us between the OCCK case and their unsolved murder of Amy Mihalevic in 1989. Amy was  
25 abducted from a small shopping center, in Bay Village Ohio, during the day, in June of 1989. Her body  
26 was discovered in a farmer's field in rural Ashland County Ohio in November of 1989. She had more  
27 than likely been molested, but due to the decay of her body, examiners were unable to say for sure.  
28 Her panties were on backwards and there was blood on them. Amy had been stabbed to death in the  
29 neck and chest. There is DNA evidence in their case. They have a suspect named Dean Runkel that  
30 currently lives in Key West, Florida. Runkel is a pedophile and was a teacher in the Cleveland area at  
31 the time of the killing. Runkel lied about ever being in Bay Village, Ohio. We gave Agent Torsney all of  
32 our info on Ted Lamborgine, including information about his DNA location. Ted Lamborgine lived on  
33 Bosworth in Cleveland at one time, which is the street that another young girl was abducted and killed  
34 (also unsolved). They are going to compare Ted's DNA to their DNA from Amy Mihalevich's case. Phil  
35 Torsney gave us information on a pedophile subject from Cleveland named James D. Moore that is  
36 currently in prison in Michigan for murder. This subject lived in the Cleveland area at the time of the  
37 OCCK case but, supposedly had access to a Gremlin and would drive to the Detroit area at that time to  
38 visit relatives. We are looking to see if there is any possible link between Runkel, Lamborgine, Moore  
39 and others that might connect these cases. We knew about James D. Moore approximately one year  
40 ago. Ray Anger (Berkley PD) had info on this guy. Garry & Ray are going this week to interview and  
41 swab James Moore at the Michigan Department of Corrections facility in Macomb Twp.

42 3-9-07: Josiah Tazelaar's Attorney (Michael Elkins) called me today and stated that his client would  
43 take the polygraph on Thursday March 22<sup>nd</sup>, at 1:00 PM. Mr. Elkins had two conditions he is  
44 requesting, prior to his client taking the polygraph. The first condition is a written immunity agreement  
45 from the prosecutor, stating that his client would not be charged with any old CSC cases subsequent to  
46 his polygraph. I spoke with Rob Moran prior to this about Elkins request. Moran stated at that time, that  
47 this immunity request would not be a problem. I left a message for Moran today stating that we would  
48 need this agreement in writing from the prosecutor's office.

49 The second condition that Elkins requested was, that he wanted approval to review his clients  
50 polygraph results after the test. I spoke with the polygraph examiner, Lt. Robert Dykstra (Michigan  
51 State Police) who stated that Elkins can review the test results through the standard FOIA process. I

1 called Elkins and informed him of this, at which time he requested this in writing. Garry & I are in the  
2 process of preparing this in writing.

3 3-9-07: \*\*\* (Ted Miller confirmed Deceased today) \*\*\* Today Garry & I went to 139 Taylor St. in  
4 Highland Park, Michigan to interview Theodore "Ted" Miller. Upon entering and speaking to the people  
5 inside, this home was identified as an adult foster care facility. We spoke with the social worker that  
6 manages the home, who told us that Ted Miller had in fact lived at that home, but recently passed  
7 away. She showed us the homes roster on the bulletin board in the lobby area. Theodore Miller was  
8 listed on the roster with a line through his name and the word **DECEASED**. I showed the social worker  
9 a photograph of Ted Miller from 30 years ago. She stated that she believed this to be him based on the  
10 bad acne. We will have to try and interview George Richards instead. Richards was a close associate  
11 of Ted Miller and Josiah Tazelaar. Richards is alive and living in the southwest Detroit area.

12 3-11-07: This weekend I was reviewing the Ted Lamborgine files, looking for a possible connection  
13 between Lamborgine and Cleveland FBI's suspect, Dean Runkel. I was reading the confession that  
14 Lamborgine wrote to U.S. Navy Officials when he was dishonorably discharged from the Navy for  
15 homosexual acts, in the 1960's. During his confession, Lamborgine was describing his homosexual  
16 acts and stated that he is interested in pursuing a relationship with a female. This is interesting  
17 because there has never been any indication from Ted of any interest in women, although he could just  
18 be telling the Navy officials this to save face.

19 3-12-07: Today, I drove by the house located at [REDACTED] Willette in southwest Detroit. This is one of  
20 George Richard's possible addresses. The only vehicle there was an older full size grey, Grand  
21 Marquis that was parked in front. I ran the plate, which came back registered to a Timothy Brown at  
22 [REDACTED] Willette in Detroit. Another possible address for George Richards is 4100 Warren Ave. in Detroit.  
23 This is a large high-rise apartment building located on Warren Ave. between I-94 and Grand Blvd. I had  
24 dispatch run "all vehicles registered" to George Richards. The only vehicle currently registered to  
25 Richards, was a 1990 Dodge 4-door registered to Richards at 6521 Edsel Ford Fwy. Detroit, Mi. This  
26 plate was renewed on his birthday (2-1-1947) and is valid until 2-1-2008. I checked the lot at the  
27 apartments but was unable to locate this vehicle. I drove by 6521 Edsel Ford Freeway, and observed  
28 an older blue & silver full-size Ford pickup truck parked in front. I ran the plate, which came back  
29 registered to a Steven Vernon Hernandez, at [REDACTED] Dorais in Livonia, on a 1989 Ford truck.

30 3-14-07: I received the letter on Departmental Letterhead today from Garry Gray (MSP), in response  
31 to Josiah Tazelaar's Attorney's request for a letter in writing, stating that he could have a polygraph  
32 examiner of his choosing review the charts after the test. I faxed this letter to attorney Michael Elkins  
33 today. I am still waiting on the letter pertaining to the immunity agreement from the Wayne County  
34 Prosecutors office.

35 3-14-07: I did some more checking into Ralph [REDACTED] today and located him at [REDACTED] Wenonah  
36 Lane in Waterford, Mi. This is in the "Cass Lake" area off of Cass-Elizabeth Rd. I got a photo of  
37 [REDACTED] from the Secretary of State. It appears that Tankersley is currently on probation, out of the  
38 Oakland/Pontiac probation office for an O.U.I.L. arrest in July of 2005.

39 3-14-07: \*\*\* (Prosecutor Rob Moran floated the written offer to Ted's attorney today) \*\*\* Rob  
40 Moran (Wayne County Prosecutors Office) called me today and said that he had a conversation with  
41 Ted Lamborgine's attorney (Rita Young). She asked Rob for the number of years that Ted is looking at  
42 if he pleads guilty. Rob told her that Ted is looking at 25-30 years at the low end and 40-60 years at  
43 the high end. When she questioned these numbers, Rob told her that there is another option that Ted  
44 has available to him and it is in writing. Rob explained to her that Ted could possibly substantially  
45 reduce his number of years and go to a nice federal prison instead, in exchange for his cooperation.  
46 Rob told me that the attorney then wanted a number of years we were offering, to which Rob told her  
47 that he can't give her a number right now and that it would depend on what Ted can do. She is going to  
48 talk to Ted about this and call Rob back.

49 During a second conversation with Rob Moran, he stated that he mentioned to Ted's attorney, numbers  
50 as low as ten years, depending on his level of culpability and his level of cooperation. Rita Young,

1 again asked about a specific number of years, to which Moran stated that, once again he cannot given  
2 an exact amount because we do not know at this point, the level of Ted's involvement nor the level of  
3 his cooperation. Ms. Young said that she would talk to her client about this and get back to Moran.  
4 Moran told Ms. Young to call him if she or Ted has any questions about this.

5 3-14-07: \*\*\* (Conversation with Willem Tazelaar's attorney, Patrick Ball) \*\*\* I had a conversation  
6 with Willem "Bill" Tazelaar's attorney today, Patrick Ball. Mr. Ball did not understand why we want to  
7 polygraph his client, when we are already polygraphing his brother Josiah. I explained for the third or  
8 fourth time to Mr. Ball, that his client was also hanging around 88 Stevens back in the day where  
9 pedophile activity was taking place and our suspects in the OCCK case were frequenting. I went on to  
10 explain to Mr. Ball that his client was also living three blocks from where one of our victims was  
11 abducted and that his brother Josiah was visiting there often during these crimes. I also explained to  
12 Mr. Ball that Willem could have information relating to our case independent from his brother and that  
13 we need to also clear him. Mr. Ball stated that we are going to use the polygraph to charge him if he  
14 fails. I explained to Mr. Ball that a polygraph is inadmissible in court; we cannot use it as evidence and  
15 only want to clear his client so that we can move on. Mr. Ball again asked "what if his client fails it." I  
16 asked Mr. Ball, are you saying that your client is involved in the Oakland County Child Killings, to which  
17 he stated "no", and that he was not going to go there. I said "look Mr. Ball, we only want to clear your  
18 guy. This is a huge investigation that your client is in the middle of and we are obligated, one way or  
19 another to investigate him. I further stated that if he passes it, he never hears from us again." Mr. Ball  
20 stated that he understood and would talk to his client tomorrow and get back to me.

21 3-15-07: I drove by the house in Waterford today that is listed for Ralph [REDACTED] This house is  
22 located at [REDACTED] Wenonah Ln. Waterford, Michigan. This house is situated on the north side of Cass  
23 Lake and is just off Cass-Elizabeth Rd. As I was going by a small, grey Dodge Neon pulled into the  
24 driveway and the two white female occupants with children exited. The plate on this car is [REDACTED]. I  
25 performed a check of this license plate through the Secretary of State, which revealed it to be on a,  
26 1995 Dodge Neon to [REDACTED] Waterford. (probably a  
27 neighbor gal).

28 3-16-07: I met Rob Moran this morning in Circuit Court Judge Annette Berry's courtroom at the Frank  
29 Murphy Hall of Justice. I was there to get Kym Worthy's approval for Immunity for Josiah Tazelaar  
30 against prosecution from any old CSC's, as a condition of his taking a polygraph in the Oakland County  
31 Child Killing case, next week at the Northville State police post. This was also the day for the  
32 prosecution motion in Lamborgines case to consolidate the Southgate & Romulus cases against Ted.

33 While in Court, Ted's attorney (Rita Young) indicated to me that Ted wants to plead guilty to his child  
34 molestation cases and that she wanted to discuss a number of years. I told Rob this, at which time he  
35 & I had an opportunity to discuss further with Ted's attorney a possible cooperation agreement with Ted  
36 in the Oakland County Child Killing case. We gave Ted's attorney a copy of the agreement drafted by  
37 the U.S. Attorneys Office (Jennifer Gorland). She told Rob & I that Ted wants to plead guilty and is  
38 saying he can't take this deal because he didn't have anything to do with killing those kids in Oakland  
39 County. We told Ted's attorney that Ted should take the polygraph again then and permanently clear his  
40 name. She asked Rob what kind of reduction from 25 years could Ted get if he did that. Rob  
41 mentioned that we would allow Ted to plead guilty to 1 CSC 1<sup>st</sup> degree & 1 CSC 2<sup>nd</sup> degree and have  
42 the number of years reduced down to 15 years if he takes the polygraph. Rob also told Ted's attorney  
43 that if Ted fails the polygraph and discloses information about the case that solves the case, this could  
44 be reduced even further. Rita wanted to know a number of years that it could be reduced further. Rob  
45 & I both told her that it's hard to give a number because we don't know what his level of involvement or  
46 knowledge of the case is yet. She stated that she understood and we told her that we had to meet with  
47 Kym Worthy to get authorization for this 15 year agreement. Rob and I met with Ms. Worthy and she  
48 did in fact authorize Rob to make the 15 year offer to Ted's attorney in exchange for his cooperation in  
49 the OCCk case. Kym also authorized immunity to Josiah Tazelaar to take the polygraph in the OCCk  
50 case. Rob & I went back to Ted's attorney with this authorization, to which Rita stated that she would  
51 take this to Ted in the courtroom and let us know. After discussing this with Ted, she told me that Ted  
52 is requesting a week to think about it, stating that he has some things to think about. Rob Moran made

1 Judge Berry aware of this possible plea agreement and the case was adjourned until Friday March 23<sup>rd</sup>  
2 at 9:00am. At this time, Ted is going to make his decision on cooperation.

3 3-19-07: This morning we had a meeting in Wayne County Prosecutor Rob Moran's office to discuss  
4 this possible agreement with Ted. Present at the meeting was Garry Gary & Dave Robertson (MSP), I  
5 and Rob Moran. After much discussion we all agreed that the 15 years for Ted to take the polygraph,  
6 with the potential for a further reduction in years with his cooperation in the OCCK case, is the best  
7 offer we can make to him right now without knowing what he knows or his level of involvement.

8 3-19-07: This afternoon, Garry & I went to [REDACTED], to interview Ralph [REDACTED]. We  
9 identified Ralph from his photograph when he answered the door. We told him we wanted to talk to him  
10 about what was going on in the 6 Mile & Woodward area of Highland Park back in the mid to late 70's.  
11 Ralph stated that he has tried to put that life & lifestyle behind him and move on. I told Ralph that we  
12 are investigating the Oakland County Child Killings and would like to run some names and photos by  
13 him, stating that we were looking for his help. Ralph said that he would be glad to try and help us, but  
14 was watching kids at the moment. We gave Ralph our business cards and got his cellphone number  
15 and made arrangements to talk to him later in the week. I did run a couple of names by him, like Josiah  
16 or Bill Tazelaar and Bob Moore, none of which he was familiar with. I also asked him about a house on  
17 Stevens in Highland Park back in the late 70's, just east of Woodward Ave. where some adult  
18 pedophile men were staying. Ralph said as far as he remembers, that did not "ring a bell" with him, but  
19 it's been so long ago and he was a kid.

20 3-21-07: Today, Rob Moran (Wayne County Prosecutors Office, Homicide Unit) faxed me the letter of  
21 Use Immunity for Josiah Tazelaar. This letter is in regards to three specific, 30 year old C.S.C.'s  
22 committed by Josiah Tazelaar. The letter was signed by Elizabeth Walker, the Deputy Chief of Special  
23 Prosecutions at the Wayne County Prosecutors Office. I faxed a copy of the Use Immunity agreement  
24 to Michael Elkins office. They called and confirmed that they had received it via fax.

25 3-21-07: \*\*\* (Phone interview of [REDACTED]) \*\*\* I spoke to Ralph [REDACTED] on the phone  
26 today for a few minutes. He was working in Ann Arbor and was unable to make it in today for an  
27 interview. I asked Ralph if he knows or has an idea about who may have been involved in the Oakland  
28 County Child Killings. Ralph told me that he did not know, but always thought that Kent Schultz may  
29 have been involved, but that is just a feeling he had. I ran names by him like Richard Lawson, Josiah  
30 "Joe" Tazelaar & Willem "Bill" Tazelaar, along with Bob Moore & Ted Lamborgine, a.k.a. Ted Orr.  
31 Ralph stated that he did not recognize any of those names but would have to see their pictures. I  
32 asked Ralph if there was someone who controlled the money or set-up the meets with the adult men, to  
33 which he stated, no he just did it on his own for the money, like all the boys in his neighborhood. I had  
34 noticed in the MSP tip files the name Elmer Lloyd [REDACTED]. I asked Ralph if he knows who that is, to  
35 which he stated that was his dad, who is dead now. There were two tips called in on Elmer [REDACTED]  
36 in 1977.

37 3-22-07: \*\*\* (Info from Lawson through attorney David Steingold) \*\*\* Rob Moran called me today  
38 and said that he was contacted by an attorney named David Steingold, whose client (Barry Flannery) is  
39 Richard Lawson's cellmate in Jackson Prison. Steingold told Moran that Lawson is willing to give  
40 information about the Oakland County Child Killings to his cellmate Flannery so that Flannery can "help  
41 himself out" of pending federal charges. Moran talked to the U.S. Attorney about this case on Flannery,  
42 to which they stated they would work with us on this information from Flannery if he would help us on  
43 our case. We are going to explore this in the next couple of weeks.

44 3-22-07: Josiah Tazelaar and his attorney, Michael Elkins showed up today for Tazelaar's scheduled  
45 polygraph at the Northville MSP Post. I spoke with Mr. Elkins about the immunity agreement, which he  
46 thought was fine, signing same, along with Tazelaar. During the pre-polygraph interview, Lt. Dykstra  
47 (MSP examiner) asked Tazelaar if he has any heart problems. Tazelaar said he is fine now, but had  
48 valve replacement surgery two years ago. Lt. Dykstra called off the polygraph, telling Tazelaar that he  
49 would have to get a waiver from his doctor in order to take a polygraph. This polygraph will be re-  
50 scheduled if Tazelaar continues to cooperate.

1 3-23-07: We had a court date at Frank Murphy Hall of Justice today for Ted Lamborgine. While we  
2 were waiting for Judge Annette Berry to call Ted's case, we had an opportunity to talk to Ted's attorney  
3 about what Ted decided. Ms. Young told us that Ted plans on pleading guilty and that he doesn't know  
4 anything about the Oakland County Child Killings. She also said that Ted is afraid to take the  
5 polygraph. We told Ms. Young that 15 years is a great deal for Ted, to which she agreed. We told Ms.  
6 Young to tell Ted to forget the polygraph, and stated that he gives up the information in the case and  
7 we'll corroborate it another way. She then asked about ten years instead, stating that he may  
8 cooperate for that. Prosecutor Moran, stated absolutely not, saying that 15 years is a good offer and  
9 that we have not even heard what information he has yet. She went and talked it over with Ted. Garry  
10 & I watched as they, Ted and Ms. Young discussed this, at which time we observed some emotions out  
11 of Ted. His jaw appeared to be shaking as he teared up. Ms. Young came back to us and stated that if  
12 we cannot come down to 10 years, Ted is going to plead guilty to all 19 counts of CSC. Moran told her  
13 fine, indicating to Ms. Young that we would accept his plea. Just prior to the court calling Ted's case,  
14 she spoke with him again and then came over to Rob Moran and asked for an adjournment, indicating  
15 that Ted wanted a couple more days to think about things. They are seeing if we would come down  
16 from the 15 years. The case is adjourned until Wednesday March 28<sup>th</sup>, 2007 at 9:00 AM. Ted will have  
17 to make a decision at that time and his attorney indicated to Rob that they have no plans on going to  
18 trial. This was interesting today.

19 We believe the problem Ted is having, is the fact that he was more involved than he wishes he had  
20 been at this point to try and get himself a deal. We think Ted is confused on how to help himself out,  
21 when he himself is culpable and possibly one or more of the other person(s) involved may be  
22 deceased. Or possibly he acted alone during the OCCK case.

23 3-23-07: I called John Oulette (FBI) this afternoon and asked him what he thought about trying to  
24 polygraph Clark Lankey prior to Ted's next court date on the 28<sup>th</sup>. We agreed it may give us an  
25 "additional card in our hand" when negotiating with Ted on the 28<sup>th</sup>. I called Lt. Bob Dykstra (MSP),  
26 who agreed to conduct the polygraph on [REDACTED] at the Northville post on Tuesday the 27<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 AM.  
27 On Monday, Garry & I will approach [REDACTED] at his work in Livonia about this polygraph.

28 3-26-07: Today, Garry & I went to Lockwood Industries in Livonia to talk to Clark [REDACTED] about taking  
29 a polygraph on Tuesday 3-27-07. We talked with Clark and told him that we have an opening for him to  
30 take a polygraph tomorrow, reminding him that he said months ago that he would take one. Clark said  
31 that he would and then asked us if he's going to be arrested? We told him "no," indicating that we just  
32 want to clear him about what he had told us, involving Ted Lamborgine, "Duffy," Bob Moore and others.  
33 We told Clark that we would pick him up at 9:30 AM and take him to the polygraph. He agreed and  
34 said he would see us tomorrow.

35 3-27-06: Today we polygraphed Clark [REDACTED] at the MSP, Northville Post, on his involvement or  
36 knowledge of the Oakland County Child Killings. Lt. Robert Dykstra (MSP) polygraph examiner  
37 conducted the test. Present at the test were detectives Garry Gray & myself. During the polygraph  
38 examination, Clark was asked, the following questions by Lt. Dykstra:

- 39 1. In 1976-77, in Oakland County, did you participate in killing any of those kids? "No"  
40 2. Were you present when any of those kids were killed? "No"  
41 3. Did anyone tell you they killed any of those kids from Oakland County? "No"  
42 4. Did you see anyone kill any of those kids from Oakland County in 1976-77? "No"

43 **Polygraph Examiners report: It is the opinion of the undersigned examiner based on the**  
44 **examination given that this subject is being truthful regarding this issue.** Clark [REDACTED] has been  
45 cleared in regards to the Oakland County Child Killing case.

46 3-28-07: Prosecutor, Rob Moran talked to Lamborgine's attorney today in court, prior to Lamborgine's  
47 case being called. His attorney, (Rita Young) told Moran that Lamborgine wants to plead guilty to all 15  
48 counts of CSC, instead of re-taking the polygraph/cooperating in the OCCK case with an opportunity to  
49 reduce his sentence to possibly 15 years.

1 Moran had indicated to Ted's attorney that no matter what Ted's level of participation in the killings  
2 was, that we could work something out with him, indicating that even if he himself were the killer, we  
3 would be willing to negotiate in order to solve the case. Ted turned down every opportunity to help  
4 himself out and to clear himself after failing the original polygraph in September 2005. We believe  
5 based on Ted's actions that he has decided to take his information about the Oakland County Child  
6 Killings to his grave. Ted's sentencing is scheduled in front of Judge Berry on April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2007.  
7 Prosecutor Moran believes Ted will be sentenced to a minimum of 25-40 years, which is a life sentence  
8 for Ted. We also believe the reason Ted did not want to help himself out and cooperate in the OCKK  
9 case, is because he does not want to be labeled "the Oakland County Child Killer." Ted can live with  
10 being a child molestor, but not a murderer. He told detectives during his interview in Ohio, after his  
11 arrest that "he does not want to be labeled a murderer or accessory to murder". It's the label that Ted's  
12 does not want attached to him.

13 3-28-07: The media (all three Detroit stations and newspapers) were all over Ted turning down this  
14 offer and pleading guilty to all charges. We released the following to them: The details of the 2 offers  
15 made to Ted and the significance of him turning those down. The fact that, by no means does this put  
16 a halt to our investigation, stating further that we are continuing to investigate Lamborgine and his  
17 associates. We also talked about how excited we are because the MSP scientists at the forensics lab  
18 in Lansing are currently processing the victim's clothes for DNA and finding DNA material. We told  
19 them that we are hopeful, but we don't know yet whether the DNA material is from the victims or the  
20 suspects, stating that it will take several months to get an answer back.

21 3-29-07: \*\*\* (Gorcyca goes to the media again and makes comments about our investigation)  
22 \*\*\* Gorcyca (Oakland County Prosecutor) tole the Oakland Press that Lamborgine probably turned  
23 down the offer, because he has no information. This totally undermines our investigation and what we  
24 are trying to do. First of all, Gorcyca is not an investigator, has no clue about our investigation and had  
25 not contacted any of us prior to making these statements to the media. He is only responding to media  
26 reports. Secondly, all the people we are investigating connected to Lamborgine that we are trying to  
27 get on the polygraph, are watching these media reports, see these remarks from Gorcyca and think, "I  
28 don't have to take the polygraph, The Oakland County prosecutor, will just say that I don't have any  
29 information either." We are working closely with the victim's families and they were aware of our  
30 investigation and are happy with what we are trying to do. David Gorcyca is just meddling in something  
31 he knows nothing about and damaging the only solid chance this case has had in 30 years. The  
32 victim's families would be very upset with Gorcyca's comments. It sure would be nice if the Oakland  
33 County prosecutor were supportive of what we are working on.

\* What is with these  
assholes in Oakland Co.?  
The worst.

34 3-29-07: This afternoon I received a phone message from Willem "Bill" Tazelaar's attorney (Patrick  
35 Ball). He stated in his message that "Bill" decided that he is not going to take the polygraph in regards  
36 to killing the kids from Oakland County. Patrick Ball left a long message, at which time he finally  
37 indicated that his client is not going to take the polygraph, because "he does not think the test is  
38 reliable". The interesting thing about this is that his client knew the four questions that we were going to  
39 ask him, specifically pertaining to killing the kids from Oakland County, and never said he's not going to  
40 take the test because he had nothing to do with the OCKK case.

41 3-29-07: Michael Elkins (Josiah Tazelaar's attorney) called and left a message this afternoon to give  
42 him a call. We are waiting for his client (Josiah) to get his medical clearance waiver to take the  
43 polygraph.

44 4-4-07: I spoke with Michael Elkins this afternoon about Josiah Tazelaar. Mr. Elkins indicated to me  
45 that he had a conversation with Josiah about this waiver and that Josiah told him that he didn't think his  
46 doctor was going to authorize a waiver to take a polygraph, due to the condition of his (Josiah's) heart.  
47 Mr. Elkins told me that he was not certain of that yet and would call me when he gets the doctor's  
48 determination in writing from Josiah. (Sounds like Josiah came up with a good excuse, not to take it).
