

1 **8-28-08:** *** Gunnels was re-approached today about taking the polygraph. *** John Ouellet &
Sean Callahan (FBI) went to see Vince Gunnels today at Ryan Correctional, about taking the
polygraph in the OCCK case. Gunnels sister, a few months ago, talked Gunnels out of taking the
4 test. Gunnels, needs to be polygraphed about possible having information from Busch and/or
5 Greene about the OCCK case. After a brief discussion with Gunnels, he agreed to take the
6 polygraph, but stated he was going to talk to his sister in Montana first. Until he can be cleared by a
7 polygraph, he will still be considered a possible suspect in the OCCK case and his parole will
8 continue to be denied.

9 **9-15-08:** I have spent the last 6-8 weeks, typing the template that we will use for the affidavit to
10 search Busch's home on Morningview Terrace. I pulled out the most important information from the
11 -70-page report on this lead and put it into a 15-page affidavit to use as a guide while constructing
12 the final draft of the affidavit & search warrant.

13 **9-23-08:** The Task Force met today and, using this template, we put together a brief, 6-page
14 search warrant & affidavit to present to the Oakland County Prosecutors Office for approval to
15 search Busch's home on Morningview Terrace. Garry Gray (MSP) is going to make arrangements
16 with the MSP Forensics Unit (Crime Lab) to conduct the search of Busch's former home. Present at
17 this meeting, along with myself, was Garry Gray & Dave Robertson (MSP) and John Ouellet & Sean
18 Callahan (FBI).

19 **9-29-08:** As of today's date, we have not yet heard back from Vince Gunnels or his sister in
20 regards to Vince taking the polygraph. John Ouellet (FBI) is going to call Gunnel's sister and return
21 to the prison to talk to Gunnels about this.

22 **10-1-08:** As of today's date, we still have not heard back from Gunnels or his sister about taking the
23 polygraph. Meanwhile, Gunnels remains in prison and will continue to have his parole denied until
24 he can be cleared in the OCCK case. Because of his refusal to take the polygraph, the task force
cannot clear him, so he remains a suspect in the case and could remain in prison until his maximum
26 "out-date" which is 2027. If he takes the polygraph and is cleared, he is no longer a suspect and can
27 be immediately paroled. *** It's interesting, because he claims to have no involvement or
28 information about the case, yet he won't take the polygraph to clear his self and be released
29 from prison. Gunnels spent a lot of time with Busch & Greene in the late 70's. He was a
30 victim of both men and was the only one, of all the children they molested, that was
31 approached by Busch's mother, attempting to pay Gunnels to keep quiet about her son.***

32 **10-2-08:** *** More physical evidence was located today at the FBI storage facility in Detroit,
33 including the human hair recovered from King during the autopsy *** Garry Gray (MSP) &
34 John Ouellet (FBI) went to the FBI office in Detroit today to pick-up some trace evidence that has
35 been stored at this facility for many years. While recovering this property, they found packages
36 containing animal hairs that had been recovered from Jill Robinson's jacket during her autopsy
37 during the original investigation. ** This means that animal hairs have now been found on ALL
38 four victims clothing. Prior to finding these hairs, it was thought that only 3 of the 4 victims
39 clothing had animal hairs (white dog hairs) on them. Garry & John found more evidence at
40 FBI lab in Detroit. Along with the animal hairs, they found the human hair that had been recovered
41 from the genital area of Timothy King during his autopsy March 23rd, 1977. The M.E., Warner Spitz,
42 stated in his report that he believed this to be a suspect hair, due to the fact that the victim did not
43 yet have hair in his genital area. This hair had, originally been collected at the time of King's
44 autopsy by State Police Crime Lab personnel. On March 28th, 1977, Livonia Detectives received a
45 report from the State Police Crime Lab, stating they believe this hair to be a human facial hair. Until
46 today, we have been unable to locate this hair. It does not appear at this time that this hair has
47 been processed for DNA and may be the single piece of physical evidence needed to solve
48 this case.

1 **10-6-08:** I met with Rob Moran from the Wayne County Prosecutors office today and picked up
2 copies of the transcripts from the motions with Attorney Feinberg involving his client Larry Wasser,
3 back in October of 2007. **These transcripts had been previously ordered sealed by the court of**
4 **appeals.** Judge Kenny signed an order to release a copy of the transcripts for investigators for
5 investigation purposes.

6 **10-6-08:** John Ouellet called me tonight and stated that he spoke with Gunnels sister, Karen
7 Zaspel who resides in Montana. John said that Zaspel told her that her brother has been approved
8 for parole by the parole board. As far as the task force knew, Gunnels would not be paroled until he
9 cooperated in the OCKK investigation into Busch & Greene and took a polygraph to clear him. John
10 stated that the sister indicated that she still might have Gunnels cooperate and take the polygraph,
11 prior to leaving Michigan. I called and left a message for Garry Gray (MSP) to see if he can contact
12 the parole board in Lansing and find out if Gunnels has in-fact been paroled and will be leaving the
13 state soon?

14 **10-7-08:** I spoke with Garry Gray. He confirmed that Gunnels is due to be paroled in approximately
15 3 weeks. Garry contacted Lt. Dykstra (MSP Polygraph Examiner), who agreed to administer the
16 polygraph to Gunnels on Friday October 10th, 2008. Gunnels, taking the polygraph also depends on
17 whether or not his sister in Montana allows him to take it. She is still acting as his attorney and
18 advising him on this matter. Garry contacted the inspector at the Ryan Correctional facility, where
19 Gunnels is housed and requested that the inspector asked Gunnels if he's willing to take the
20 polygraph on Friday. The inspector called Garry back and told him that Gunnels said he would
21 consider taking the test on Friday, but wanted to run it by his sister first and would let the inspector
22 know tomorrow.

23 **10-7-08:** I then called Karen Zaspel on her cellphone and left a message about this. To make sure
24 she heard it from us first, so she didn't think we were trying to trick her brother or go around her on
25 this. I informed her that we have a polygraph scheduled for Friday Oct. 10th and when her brother
26 passes and cleared, he can be paroled in just a few weeks afterwards.

27 **10-7-08: *** Notified Oakland County Prosecutor's Office today about this lead & requested to**
28 **meet with them ***** Garry Gray, contacted Assistant Oakland County Prosecutor "Ed" Cybor today
29 to set a time for the Task Force to come in and meet with, brief them and get approval for this
30 search warrant for Busch's home. Garry gave Cybor a few details about what this search warrant
31 has to do with. A meeting was scheduled for Tuesday October 14th, 2008 at 1:00pm.

32 **10-8-08: *** Gunnels agreed to take the polygraph ***** John Ouellet (FBI) called me today and
33 stated that he spoke with Vince Gunnels and Gunnels sister, Karen Zaspel, and that Gunnels has
34 agreed to take the polygraph scheduled for 10:00am Friday October 10th, 2008. I talked to Garry
35 Gray (MSP) today who stated that he has already obtained a "writ" for Gunnels to take the
36 polygraph.

37 **10-10-08: *** Gunnels took the polygraph today at the MSP Northville post ***** Gunnels took
38 the polygraph today at the MSP 2nd District Headquarters in Northville, Mi. D/Lt. Robert Dykstra was
39 the polygraph examiner that conducted the test. During the pre-test interview and some pre-test
40 questioning, Gunnels was acting very nervous and asked Agent John Ouellet (FBI) 3 times, "what
41 happens if the test is inconclusive?" **Inconclusive is a police term. He's been talking to**
42 **someone prior to the test.** Gunnels kept holding and reading the bible in the room during breaks,
43 prior to taking the test and looking back at the bible in the room while answering questions. At one
44 point during the pre-test, Gunnels was shown a photograph of the 4 victims from the OCKK case
45 and became very upset, asking, "how do I know whether or not these are the same four kids?"

46 Lt. Dykstra showed Gunnels a photo of Greg Greene, but never told Gunnels who it was in the
47 picture. Gunnels, has maintained all along that he doesn't know Greene. Gunnels became upset
48 about these photos and demanded to talk to Agent Ouellet who was in the other room, along with
49 other Task Force members, observing the pre-test questioning on CCTV. When Ouellet entered the

1 room, Gunnels, upset, stated, " what are they doing showing me a picture of Greg Greene, indicating
2 he does in-fact know Greene.

3 Lt Dykstra then administered the polygraph to Gunnels about his involvement in, and/or having
4 information about the child killings. After the test was completed, Lt Dykstra reviewed the polygraph
5 charts and determined that Gunnels had purposely altered the results of the test. Gunnels held his
6 breath during questioning, along with taking quick short breaths, tapping his feet and moving around,
7 all of which resulted in the test being an "inconclusive." Gunnels himself stated to Lt Dykstra, before
8 reviewing the charts, that he may have been moving around a bit during the test.

9 Prior to Gunnels receiving the results of the test, Agent Ouellet, "swabbed" the inside of Gunnels
10 cheek for DNA. This swab was then packaged, initialed and turned over to Sgt. Gray (MSP), to be
11 shipped to the FBI Lab in Quantico Virginia for analysis and comparison.

12 After the test, when reviewing the results with Gunnels, he denied purposely holding his breath
13 and sabotaging the test, but later told Agent Ouellet and Sgt. Gray that his cellmate had talked to
14 him about how to beat a polygraph. This would match Gunnels using the term "inconclusive" prior to
15 taking the test. ***** It's interesting that after all this time of Gunnels insisting he had nothing to
16 do with the child killings or held any information about them, he still purposely sabotaged the
17 test to force an inconclusive result. This leads investigator's to believe that an inconclusive
18 was his only hope of being paroled, knowing that he could not pass the test. Gunnels at this
19 point, is still not "cleared" in the child killing case and is considered a co-suspect.**

20 **10-13-08: *** Garry Gray & I briefed the State Police Crime Lab director and scientist today
21 on the upcoming search of Busch's home ***** We met today with the director of the lab, D/Lt.
22 Charlie Morden, Heather Vitta from the DNA unit and Guy Nutter from the Trace Evidence unit. We
23 briefed them on this lead, showed them pictures of Busch's home and explained what type of
24 physical evidence it is we are looking for and why. They explained some of the methods they would
25 use to collect hairs & fibers in the home and the possibilities of finding and recovering this evidence.
26 They are going to purchase a vacuum to be used specifically for the search of this home, which will
27 include vacuuming the air-duct system of the home, pulling back carpeting & baseboards... etc.

28 **10-14-08: *** Today it was determined that Greene was possibly out on bond at the time of
29 King's abduction ***** Garry Gray was reviewing some old notes today from Task Force Detective
30 Doan (Southfield PD) and observed where Doan had written the following statement: "Greene was
31 sent to Jackson Prison on 6-17-77. "Out on bond till then." This means that Greene may have
32 posted bond sometime between February of 1977 and when he went to prison in June of 77. King
33 was abducted and killed in March of 1977.

34 **10-14-08: *** Met with Oakland County Prosecutors today, presented our case and requested
35 approval to search Busch's home. ***** The Task Force met with Assistant Oakland County
36 Prosecutors Ed Cybor & Gary Tunis today. Present from the Task Force, along with myself was
37 Garry Gray & Dave Robertson (MSP) and John Ouellet & Sean Callahan (FBI). We briefed them on
38 this lead, what we've developed, how it was developed, showed them pictures and explained why
39 we want to search the Busch's home. They were very interested and stated they would look it all
40 over and get back to us. Tunis indicated that he didn't see any reason that they wouldn't approve
41 the search warrant, but simply indicated that a few changes and additions would have to be made to
42 it first. Tunis further stated that it sounded like plenty of probable cause existed to search this home.

43 **10-15-08: *** Kym Worthy offered today, to convene a Grand Jury in this case to compel
44 those like Wasser, Brent Busch, Gunnels, Cabot and maybe others to answer questions
45 truthfully in regards to this case or face jail time. I relayed her offer to Sgt. Gray (MSP).** *

46 **10-16-08:** I was reading through some of the reports on Busch from 1977, and found the sex
47 motivated report that was filled out by Midland County Sheriffs when Busch was charged. In this
48 report it states that Busch's parents attempted to "buy off" the victim in this case. The victim in this

1 case was "Vince" Gunnels. This matches what Gunnels told Sgt.'s Williams & Gray during an
interview with Gunnels at Camp Ojibway in March of 2008. Gunnels told investigators that Busch's
mom came to Flint in a limousine, called him over to the car and tried to pay him off.

4 **10-17-08:** I called Huntington Beach PD in California today and spoke with a Yolanda in the
5 Records Bureau. She looked up Greg Greene's case from 1974, when he was charged with
6 Kidnapping, False Imprisonment and numerous counts of Child Molestation. Yolanda stated that
7 due to the seriousness of this case they did save it and have the originals files available. I faxed a
8 written request for the entire file on Greene. She stated that a detective at their department would
9 look over my request and make contact with me about getting a copy of their files.

10 **10-20-08: *** (Received the Huntington Beach PD reports today, on Greene's arrest in 1974,
11 for multiple CSC's in Huntington, California) ***** This police report, outlined the investigation into
12 the incident that led to Greene being arrested, charged with 45-50 counts of Child Molestation, False
13 Imprisonment, attempted murder and then being sent to a state mental hospital where he did only 6-
14 12 months and was released. During the interview of Greene, after his arrest, he named at least 15
15 young male victims that he had molested and sodomized many times, adding that he had molested
16 children over 200 hundred times while in California. Greene told police he worked with a pedophile
17 friend named Ed Mahon who ran the baseball league that Greene coached in. Greene told police
18 that Mahon was also a pedophile and gave Greene a job coaching in ex-change for Greene bringing
19 young boys to Mahon for him to molest.

20 The incident in which Greene was arrested and jailed for, involved a 12 year-old, w/m victim
21 named [REDACTED] California. Greene took this boy out to a drive
22 in, got him some alcohol and marijuana and then, after dark, told the boy that they were going to go
23 retrieve a bicycle that Greene had stolen earlier and stashed near the baseball fields. Greene took
24 this boy to the wooded area of the fields, near the San Diego Freeway and began to molest him.
25 Greene performed oral sex on this boy then the boy became uncooperative. **Based on admissions
26 to the police by Greene, about anally, sexually molesting boys that is probably what Greene
27 was attempting to do when this boy became uncooperative.** Greene told the police that he
28 struck the boy in the neck to keep him quiet and then put his hand over the boy's mouth until he was
29 quiet. The doctors determined that the boy had actually been strangled by Greene and showed
30 abrasions on the inside of the mouth where Greene had held his hand over the boy's mouth.

31 After the boy was unconscious or dead, Greene held a lit cigarette up to the boys nose in an
32 attempt to wake him. When this didn't work, Greene pushed the lit cigarette into the skin on the
33 boys "belly" 3 times attempting to see if the boy would wake up or was alive. Greene, then drug the
34 boy through the woods & field to his car and dumped him face down in the back seat of his car.
35 Greene then drove around L.A. trying to figure out what to do with this boy. Greene eventually drove
36 near an area hospital and dumped the boy, who was still unconscious, on the grass around the
37 corner from the hospital. **Greene did not know whether the boy was alive or dead at this time.**
38 Greene then drove across the street from the hospital to a payphone and called the hospital about
39 this boy, stating that he found the boy unconscious and he thinks he needs help. Greene did not
40 give his name. After driving around, Greene checked to see if they found the boy and they had not,
41 so he called again. The boy was eventually found, was alive and treated. **This M.O. of Greg
42 Greene's (or handling of the victim) is very similar to OCCK case, in regards to the age of the
43 boy, anally molested, strangled/suffocated and dumped in an area where they would be
44 found. (See Huntington Beach Police Department's report for details. Busch has also put his
45 hand over a boy's mouth to keep him quiet when he was screaming. Busch did this to Vince
46 Gunnels at Busch's house in Alma when Busch was trying to anally molest Gunnels. (See
47 interview transcripts of Gunnels interview at Camp Ojibway for details.**

1 **10-21-08: *** Briefed Oakland County Prosecutor David Gorcyca on upcoming search**
2 **warrant ***** Garry & I met with Oakland County Prosecutor David Gorcyca today, briefed him on
3 this lead and discussed how the search warrant was going to be handled. Also at this meeting was
4 Assistant Oakland County Prosecutors, Gary Tunis & Ed Cybor. Gorcyca was very encouraged by
5 this lead and said that it was the best lead he has seen in the OCCK case in the 13 years he's been
6 around Oakland County.

7 **10-21-08: *** (Vince Gunnels sister, Karen Zaspel, called me today about the results of the**
8 **polygraph test) ***** She stated that she spoke with Vince and he told her that no one at the prison
9 is doing anything to get Vince paroled. I explained to Karen that Vince did not keep his end of the
10 bargain by taking the polygraph. I explained that he purposely sabotaged the test by moving,
11 holding his breath and taking short, quick breaths during the questions. She asked how we know he
12 did this on purpose. I explained that the examiner is a seasoned veteran examiner and that the
13 charts revealed Vince had done this on purpose. I also explained that Vince himself told Detectives
14 after the test that his cell-mate had schooled him on beating a polygraph by getting an inconclusive.
15 I told Karen that it's interesting that he would need to learn how to beat a polygraph after he insisted
16 for months that he has no information, nor was he involved in the OCCK case and that's solely what
17 the test is in regards to. I explained that we are not going to assist Vince in getting paroled until he
18 can take the test and answer the questions properly. She said okay and that she would be in touch.

19 **10-22-08: *** (Re-interviewed Greg Greene's brother James Greene today) ***** I spoke on the
20 phone today with Greg's brother James and asked him again if he, Greg and their other brother
21 Robert all had the same mom & dad, to which James stated they did. He said that their family lives
22 in Detroit until the late forties/early fifties when the family moved to Flint. I mentioned Greg telling
23 the police in 1977, that he and his father (Luke Greene) would go visit relatives and friends in
24 Detroit. James stated that their father's brother (their uncle, Al Greene) lived in the Farmington Hills
25 area, but stated that it could have been Farmington, Livonia, stating that he wasn't sure but would
26 check and call me back. James stated that they would visit their uncle Al and his son Allen or Alan
27 Greene (their cousin) occasionally and gave me the route they took to get there from Flint. James
28 said that they would come down 23 to eastbound I-696 into Farmington Hills to get to the house. I
29 asked if they came down I-275, to which James stated he didn't think that that highway was
30 complete at that time. James stated that their mother had relatives in the area too, named
31 "O'Donnell." I asked James about any friend that Greg or their family might have had in the
32 Ferndale area, to which James stated he doesn't remember anything like that. I asked James if he
33 remembers the long letter that Greg sent them from prison, outlining his life, to which James stated
34 he did, stating further that his brother Robert had thrown it away after Greg died. James stated that
35 his brother Robert told him that he threw it away because he (Robert) didn't want his own kids to see
36 the contents of the letter. I asked James to talk to Robert and see if he remembers anything in the
37 letter Greg wrote, stating that he had information about our killings or that Busch told him he did it,
38 anything like that. James stated he would talk with Robert and call me back.

39 **10-23-08: *** Faxed request to Patton State Mental Hospital in California for Greene's**
40 **records. (See copy of faxed request in Greene's file and in binder under section for Greene).**

41 **10-24-08: *** (Received a copy of Greene's records from Patton State Hosp. Today) ***** The
42 woman I spoke to at Patton State Hospital (Allison Cunningham), informed me that the file they sent
43 me on Greene is what they call a "skeleton file." It is called this because it was an old case and
44 had since been cleaned out, except for the basics, for storage purposes. This file did include intake
45 and discharge information along with a detailed case summary on Greene. (See this record in
46 Greene's file or section in Binder on Greene). This file, showed that Greene had been sentenced to
47 Patton State Hospital on 1-28-75, by Judge Kenneth E. Lae.

48 **10-27-08:** Garry Gray, Dave Robertson (MSP) & I, met with Oakland County Prosecutor Dave
49 Gorcyca today to discuss the plan for notifying the family in the home we are going to search on

1 Wednesday, October 29th, 2008. Also present at this meeting was Deb Carly, Gary Tunis & Ed
2 Cybor from The Oakland County Prosecutors Office.

3
4 **10-28-08: *** Got the search warrant for Busch's home, signed today in 48th Dist. Court *****
5 Garry & I met with Oakland County APA Gary Tunis today and reviewed the search warrant for [REDACTED]
6 [REDACTED] Once the search warrant was finalized, and approved
7 by the prosecutor, we took it to the 48th District Court to be approved and signed by Judge Kimberly
8 Small. Judge Small read the warrant and we gave her a brief overview of our case and the probable
9 cause that we have to search the Busch home. She approved & signed the search warrant. Judge
10 Small also approved the sealing of this warrant, along with the tabulation due to this being an on-
11 going investigation. Judge Small was excited about what we had developed in this old case and the
12 potential to possibly, finally solve it and bring closure to the families of the victims. She agreed that
13 more than enough probable cause existed to search this home, even though the crimes were
committed more than thirty years ago.

14 **10-29-08: *** Executed the Search Warrant today on Busch's home on Morningview Terrace**
15 **in Bloomfield Twp. ***** We met at 0830 this morning at 15 Mile Rd. & Lahser for a pre-search
16 warrant meeting. The following were involved in this warrant execution: D/Sgt. Williams (Livonia
17 PD), D/Sgt.'s Gray & Robertson (MSP), David Gorcyca (Oakland County Prosecutor), Chief Kurt
18 Bowden (Bloomfield Twp. PD), Capt. Steve Cook (Bloomfield Twp. PD), Det. James Hoffman
19 (Bloomfield Twp. PD), Agent Sean Callahan (FBI), along with 4 Crime Scene (Forensic) specialists
20 from the Michigan State Police Northville Forensics Lab. Gorcyca spoke with Jonathon Jones, the
21 attorney for the family that currently owns the home at [REDACTED] (The Saham
22 family). Gorcyca informed Jones that the Task Force is in possession of a valid search warrant,
23 signed by Judge Small of the District Court in Bloomfield Twp. Jones wanted Gorcyca to sign an
24 agreement that the Michigan State Police would pay for any damage that is sustained during the
25 search, and would make the arrangements for these repairs to be made in prompt fashion. Gorcyca
26 & the State Police agreed to this and signed the agreement at the house prior to the search. The
27 homeowners agreed to give consent to search the home and signed a consent form. The
28 homeowners then took the State Police Forensics people on a tour of the residence to show them
29 what changes have been made structurally and what area's of the house has not been touched.

30 The trace evidence & DNA lab personnel then searched the home at [REDACTED].
31 They searched for approximately 8-9 hours, pulling back carpeting, vacuuming under baseboards,
32 behind walls, in laundry chutes, in crawl spaces, in the air-ducts...etc. All three floors of this home
33 were completely searched for blood and trace evidence (Hairs & Fibers). The Lab personnel used
34 brand new clean vacuums to conduct this collection of evidence during their search. For integrity
35 reasons, Gray, Robertson along with myself remained outside the home until the search was
36 complete and the lab personnel had exited the home. Inside the home, with the lab personnel
37 during the search were Special Agent Sean Callahan (FBI) and 2 officers from Bloomfield Twp. PD,
38 Captain Cook & Detective Hoffman.

39 After the search of this home was complete, the Lab personnel had collected numerous bags of
40 assorted hairs, fibers, animal hairs...etc. This evidence was all collected, packaged separately from
41 different locations in the home, sealed and marked. At the Northville Laboratory, the evidence
42 removed from this home will be separated, sorted and compared to the hairs and fibers collected
43 from our victims in 1976-77. A tabulation or "Return to search warrant" was completed, listing all
44 items removed from the home.

45 **11-14-08: *** Update on evidence from Morningview Terrace ***** Garry Gray (MSP) called me
46 today to update me on the status of the evidence from the search warrant on Morningview Terrace.
47 Garry said that he received a "price-list" from the lab in California (Gen-Quest). This is the lab that is
48 going to process our animal hairs for Mitochondrial DNA. It supposedly is going to cost thousands
49 of dollars to produce the DNA profiles and do the comparisons. Garry said that his command at
50 MSP has discussed this and agreed to proceed with the testing, even though it may be costly down

1 the road. Garry told me that he has been in contact with the lab people that did the search and that
2 the shelves that were removed from the house were determined to be "Negative" for fingerprints.
3 Garry stated that they have two brand new microscopes at the lab that they will be using to
4 microscopically examine the hairs & fibers from the Busch home. The lab personnel are still sorting
5 and separating this evidence and will soon begin comparisons. If they find animal hairs that are
6 microscopically similar in nature to the animal hairs found on our victims clothing, they will be
7 forwarded to the Gen-Quest lab for Mitochondrial DNA typing. Dr. Joy Halverson, who is world
8 renowned, will be the scientist at Gen-Quest performing the DNA work on the animal hairs.

9 **11-17-08:** I forwarded Michael Boldiszar's address to Garry today at MSP so he can send a lead to
10 the State Police Detectives in the Upper Peninsula. They are going to go to make contact with
11 Boldiszar at his home and see if he is willing to meet with Garry & I to talk about Chris Busch &
12 possibly Greg Greene. I also asked Garry about whether or not Gunnels DNA Buccal Swab had
13 been shipped to the FBI Lab in Quantico yet. Garry stated that Gunnels DNA Buccal swab has in-
14 fact been shipped to Quantico for testing.

15 **12-2-08:** I spoke with Garry Gray (MSP) today. He said that there has been a change of plans and
16 that the animal hairs are all going to go to the FBI Lab in Quantico, Virginia for microscopic
17 comparison now instead of their lab doing it. The MSP Lab personnel in Northville will package-up
18 all the hairs & fibers and ship it all to the FBI Lab in Quantico. Garry said that any hairs the FBI
19 determines are similar in nature, will be packaged and sent to Gen-Quest in California for DNA
20 analysis.

21 **12-4-08:** I had a brief conversation today with Helen Dagner. She sent me an e-mail that said that
22 she found an interview she had done in the past with John Hastings father. She had asked him if he
23 knew any of the rich auto executives that live in his neighborhood, to which he stated, "well, I knew
24 Lee Busch. This is Chris Busch's father, H. Lee Busch. The Busch family lived in the same
25 neighborhood as Hastings, just a short distance away on Tuckahoe. If this statement is true,
26 it substantiates a possible connection between John Hastings & Chris Busch. Earlier this
27 year, Helen danger told Sgt. Gray that John Hastings told her that he had a good friend that
28 committed suicide November 20th, 1978 (The day Chris Busch died). The task force has
29 theorized the possibility that John Hastings, when describing any details about the OCK
30 case, was telling someone else's story.

31 **12-4-08:** I spoke with John Ouelett (FBI) today. He is going to have Sean Callahan (FBI) forward
32 an e-mail to Agent "Tommy" MacDonald in New York to re-interview Chris Busch's brother, Charles.
33 We are going to have MacDonald ask Charles Busch some more questions about a possible suicide
34 note and if he would be willing to take a polygraph. We are also going to ask him if he, Chris or any
35 of the other brothers or parents were connected to or knew the Hastings family, specifically John
36 Hastings.

37 **12-10-08:** I spoke with *neighbor of Busch Family* today, with some more questions about Christopher Busch.
38 *neighbor of Busch Family* stated that his mom and sisters Jane & Beth have information about the Busch family
39 and Busch boys and stated that they were "creeped-out" by them. He suggested I call his mother
40 and set-up an interview with her and the sisters, stating they would be glad to try and help. The
41 mom *neighbor of Busch Family* still lives across the street from the Busch home and has a number of *neighbor of Busch Family*
42 *neighbor of Busch Family*'s sister Jane *neighbor of Busch Family* lives in the Detroit area and has a number of *neighbor of Busch Family*
43 *neighbor of Busch Family* also stated that they would be able to tell us about the incident when one
44 of the sisters came home with a pornographic Polaroid.

45 Christmas Break 2008

46 **1-08-09:** I was searching through the MSP tip file disc today, checking to see if Busch or Greene
47 were listed as associates of any other suspects called in on tips to the State Police back in the 70's.
48 I found both Busch & Greene were listed 1 time each as associates of someone called in on a tip.
49 There is no suspect name listed on either one of these tips, but the person that called them in was

1 the same person, a Ward Chapman. I found a Ward Chapman, [REDACTED]
2 [REDACTED], no phone number listed at that address. These tips were #'s 23423
3 & 23487. I ran this Ward Chapman, which showed no Criminal History, no "hits" in the Michigan Sex
4 Offender Registry & No matches in Michigan Department of Corrections. His full name is Chapman,
5 Ward Thomas, w/m, [REDACTED]

6 1-12-09: I talked with Garry Gray (MSP) today about these two tips associated with Busch &
7 Greene. Garry searched the actual tip files and stated that the numbers for actual files that were
8 investigated & written-up only go as high as the 18,000 range. These tips must have come in, in the
9 late seventies or early eighties.

10 1-12-09: I found a couple of possibly old phone numbers for Ward T. Chapman in the Flint area
11 and called and left messages for Mr. Chapman to call me. These numbers are [REDACTED] listed
12 for an Ann Chapman in Flint & [REDACTED] to Ward T. Chapman at [REDACTED]
13 Michigan. Later this afternoon, I spoke with a Julie Chapman who called and stated her dad (Ward
14 Chapman) was at a funeral, but she would pass the message along and have him call me. She
15 asked what this was in regards to, and I told her it was about some old information her dad supplied
16 the police back in the 70's. She stated that I was in luck because her dad has a fantastic memory.

17 1-12-09: I spoke with Ward Chapman today on the phone. He stated that he was a Prosecuting
18 Attorney for Genesee County at the time he called in those tips to the Task Force. Mr. Chapman
19 believed that it was approximately 1977 when he called the tips in. He said that an anonymous
20 caller called their prosecutors office stating that they know who is killing the kids in Oakland County
21 and gave some information about this. I told him that Chris Busch & Greg Greene are mentioned on
22 his tip and that they were both charged with child molestation in Genesee County in 1977. Mr.
23 Chapman could not remember the name or names given and stated that Busch & Greene does not
24 "ring a bell" with him, but that it has been a long time. He stated that he remembers something
25 about the people involved were going to be at a flower show or something like that at Cobo Hall in
26 Detroit, but he wasn't sure about this. Mr. Chapman told me that Detectives from the Task Force
27 came to his office, because they thought the caller would call back. He remembered that these Task
28 Force Detectives showed him photos of the victims. Mr. Chapman was going to think about this
29 overnight and call me if he can remember more.

30 Mr. Chapman called me back later in the evening and stated that he called and spoke with an
31 Assistant Prosecuting Attorney, named Don Kuebler at the Genesee County Prosecutors Office
32 about this information. Chapman stated that Kuebler was at the prosecutor's office back in 1977.
33 Chapman told me that Kuebler, who is now the Chief of the Appellate Division, did not recall this
34 incident or information, but said he would be happy to order the Prosecutors file out of storage for us
35 on Busch & Greene. Kuebler supplied a phone number of [REDACTED]

1 **3-4-09:** I called the Texas Rangers today and left a message for Ranger A.J. Miller to call me about
2 assisting us in tracking down and interviewing Dale Cooper. We decided that they may be able to
3 take care of this sooner than the FBI.

4 **3-5-09:** I went to the Berkley Public Library today and located Mike Boldiszar in the 1976 Berkley
5 High yearbook. He was in the junior class photos. I checked the 1977 yearbook for his senior
6 photo, but could not locate him. (He may have dropped out). I was able to obtain a nice digital
7 photo of Boldiszar from the yearbook.

8 **3-5-09:** MSP Detectives Ingrid Dean & Robin Sexton made contact with Mike Boldiszar, who
9 agreed to talk with Detectives Gray & Williams. Boldiszar gave a phone number of [REDACTED]
10 and asked that Gray & I contact him to schedule an interview.

11 **3-5-09: *** (The Task Force received information of a Mitochondrial DNA match in this lead**
12 **today. This is the first physical evidence match in the O.C.C.K.'s 33 year history.) ***** DNA
13 Scientist Connie Fischer called Sgt. Gray (MSP) on this date and informed him that there is a
14 Mitochondrial DNA sequence match to one of the suspects we had swabbed for DNA in this lead.
15 Dr. Fischer stated that the DNA Sequence developed from one of the two hair fragments removed
16 from the shirt of Kristine Mihelich, matches the Mitochondrial DNA sequence of James "Vince"
17 Gunnels. Dr. Fischer stated that 1 % of the Caucasian population have this sequence. (See official
18 FBI Lab report for details). **This DNA match could now possibly corroborate Gunnels actions**
19 **and statements prior to, during, and after the polygraph in this case. This DNA match to**
20 **Gunnel's, could also be consistent with the current Task Force theory that Gunnels may have**
21 **been used as a "Lure" or to assist the killer(s) in the Child Killings. It may also simply be a**
22 **transfer due to Gunnels close association with Busch & Greene at that time.**

23
24 **3-6-09:** Garry & I met with Wayne County A.P.A. Rob Moran today at the MSP Metro North Post
25 and briefed him on the new developments in this lead involving a **DNA Match to Vince Gunnels**
26 and his connection to Busch & Greene and the OCCK case.

27
28 **3-6-09:** Garry called Michigan Department of Corrections today and made arrangements for he & I
29 to interview Gunnels ex-cellmate at the "Gus Harrison Correctional Facility" in Adrian, Michigan. The
30 ex-cellmates name is Daniel Spadorcia, who is serving 1day to Life for Sexual Deviance charges.

31
32 **3-9-09: *** The Task Force held a briefing today at the MSP Metro North Post to bring the**
33 **Wayne & Oakland Prosecutors "up to speed" on the new DNA developments in the Busch &**
34 **Greene lead. The Prosecutors were also briefed on Gunnels connection to Busch & Greene**
35 **and his possible connection to the Child Killings. The following is a list of those present at**

9 **3-10-09: *** (Interview of Gunnels cellmate) ***** Sgt's Williams & Gray went to the "Gus
10 Harrison" Correctional Facility (MDOC) in Adrian, Michigan to interview the cellmate of Vince
11 Gunnels, that was his cellmate at the time of Gunnels polygraph in October 2008. Detectives
12 interviewed cellmate, Dan Spadorcia, who stated he knew why Detectives were there, stating it's
13 probably about Vince Gunnels. Spadorcia told Detectives that he had several conversations with
14 Gunnels over the 4 months they were cellmates, about polygraphs and specifically about
15 inconclusive polygraph results. Spadorcia said that he explained to Gunnels what inconclusive
16 meant, but did not tell him how to obtain an inconclusive result on a test. Spadorcia told Detectives
17 that Gunnels told him that when he (Gunnels) was 15 years old, he was associating and being
18 molested by a guy that killed multiple people. Spadorcia stated that he believed Gunnels told him
19 that the victims were kids. Detectives asked Spadorcia if Gunnels was stating this as a fact or from
20 first hand knowledge, or was he repeating this from what Gunnels knows about our investigation.
21 Spadorcia stated that he didn't know, but that he felt Gunnels was really holding back information
22 about these murders and said we should track Gunnels down. Spadorcia also, at one point in the
23 interview stated that he wished he, would have never been dragged into this. **Spadorcia may have**
24 **been minimizing about his conversations with Gunnels and about the inconclusive test.**
25 **Spadorica may also have been minimizing what Gunnels had relayed to him about his**
26 **knowledge and/or involvement in the OCK case.**

27 **3-12-09: *** (Interview of Boldiszar in the U.P.) ***** Sgt's Williams & Gray went to Curtis,
28 Michigan to interview Mike Boldiszar about his connection to Christopher Busch. Boldiszar was the
29 boy mentioned in the police report by Busch when the Task force was interviewing him in January of
30 1977 after his (Busch's) arrest for CSC 1. Busch mentioned Boldiszar in his 77 interview as a boy
31 he picked up in the 12 mile & Greenfield area that he took to Hartfields bowling alley and the 7-11.
32 This was the third of the 3 places Busch named in this report as the places he has picked up kids in
33 the past. **While doing so, Busch named the 3 OCK victim abduction sites in chronological**
34 **order. The 4th victim (King) had not occurred yet.**

35
36 Boldiszar admitted knowing Chris Busch, stating that Busch was a "Big Brother" of his, from the
37 "Big Brother" program in the early 70's, in the Birmingham, Berkley area. Boldiszar stated that
38 Busch would take him to and frequented the "Tiny Tim's" hobby shop at 13 mile & Woodward and
39 also Hartfields bowling alley on 12 Mile Rd. in Berkley. **These are both abduction locations of**
40 **OOCK victims. Jill Robinson, was believed to have been abducted from the area of the "Tiny**
41 **Tim's" hobby Shop near 13 Mile & Woodward in Royal Oak. Kristine Mihelich was abducted**
42 **near the Hartfields bowling alley and the 7-11 on 12 Mile Rd. in Berkley.** Boldiszar told
43 Detectives, that Busch took him to the Busch cottage one time, where Chris Busch attempted to
44 molest him. Boldiszar stated that he fought off Busch's attempts to molest him at that time, and that
45 Busch was never successful at molesting him. Boldiszar also said that while at the Busch cottage,
46 Chris Busch taught him how to shoot a 12-gauge shotgun. **It was determined during the original**
47 **investigation, that victim Jill Robinson was shot with a 12-gauge shotgun.**

48
49 ***** As of March 13th, 2009, arrangements are being made for Task Force members to go to**
50 **Montana and question Vince Gunnels about his connection to the Child Killings, his**
51 **connection to Christopher Busch & Greg Greene, and to explain his DNA being on the shirt of**
52 **OOCK victim Kristine Mihelich.**

3 **3-20-09: *** (The fibers from the victims clothing was located today) ***** Garry Gray (MSP)
4 went to the Michigan State Police Long Term Storage Facility today with MSP Northville, Lab
5 Scientists Cheryl Lozen & Lori Bruski to search for the slides containing the fibers from the OCK
6 victims clothing. These fibers were removed from the victims during the original autopsies in the
7 70's and also during the more recent forensic examinations. The slides containing these fibers were
8 located and will be compared to the fibers removed from Busch's home during the search warrant in
9 October of 2008. During examination of this evidence, it was determined there is also some
10 unknown human hairs that will have to be processed.

11 **3-23-09: *** (The trip to Montana was cancelled today, Gunnels absconded from parole) *****
12 All flights and arrangements were made for 5 of us to go to Butte, Montana on 3-24-09 to interview
13 Gunnels. The following were scheduled to go on this trip: Garry Gray (MSP), Cory Williams (Livonia
14 PD), Shelley Holloway (Livonia PD), Sean Callaghan (FBI) & Rob Moran (Wayne County
15 Prosecutors Office). Garry called today and said that the trip for tomorrow is cancelled because
16 Gunnels absconded on Friday evening and his parole people in Butte, Montana were not exactly
17 sure where he was. Gunnels, is due to report on Tuesday March 26th for a hearing regarding
18 Gunnels being expelled recently from the homeless shelter across from the parole office. This
19 hearing is to decide whether or not he can return to the shelter. The Montana parole officers are not
20 sure if Gunnels is going to show up for that hearing or not. Sean Callaghan (FBI) made a call to
21 Gunnels sister, who stated she new about Gunnels not reporting and also knew his whereabouts,
22 but was not going to tell Callaghan.

23
24 **3-24-09: *** (Gunnels warrant for "Full Extradition" was entered today by the Lansing,**
25 **Michigan tether unit) ***** At 9:56am this morning, the warrant was entered into N.C.I.C. for James
26 Vincent Gunnels for parole absconding. Garry called me this morning and stated that he has
27 contacted all the local law enforcement agencies in the Butte, Montana area for assistance in getting
28 Gunnels locked-up on this warrant.

29
30 **3-25-09: *** (Gunnels arrested on the MDOC warrant in Butte, Montana on 3-24-09. He is in-**
31 **custody at the Silver Bow County Jail in Butte) ***** Garry Gray(MSP) called me this morning
32 stating that he just received a call from Gunnels Parole Officer (Ted Barry) in Butte, stating that
33 Gunnels had been picked up on his warrant. Gunnels, showed-up at one of the other nearby
34 shelters in Butte during the evening of 3-24-09, and was arrested.

35
36 **3-26-09: *** (The Task Force flew to Butte, Montana today to interview Vince Gunnels) *****
37 The following Task Force members went to Butte for the interviews of Vince Gunnels & his sister
38 Karen Zaspel: D/Sgt. Cory Williams (Livonia PD), D/Sgt. Garry Gray (MSP), D/Sgt. Shelley
39 Holloway (Livonia PD) & A.P.A. Robert Moran (Wayne County Prosecutors Office). During the early
40 evening hours on today's date, we interviewed James Vincent Gunnels at the Butte/Silver-Bow
41 Sheriff's Department in Butte, Montana. Sgt. Gray started the interview talking with Gunnels,
42 reading him his rights and explaining that the Task Force is now in possession of his (Gunnels) DNA
43 that was located on the shirt of Kristine Mihelich. Sgt. Gray tried to show Gunnels a picture of
44 Mihelich while explaining the DNA. Gunnels would not look at the photo and continued to sit back in
45 his chair with his eyes closed, listening. Gunnels did not deny anything, but simply said he wants an
46 attorney and he's not saying anything without one. Any questioning of Gunnels stopped. Sgt.
47 Holloway explained to Gunnels that he could have an attorney, she would not ask him any
48 questions, and asked, would he simply listen to what she had to say? Gunnels agreed. Sgt.
49 Holloway explained that he was only 14/15 years old when he was associating with Busch & Greene
50 in 1976-77 and that he was a victim of theirs. Sgt. Holloway explained to Gunnels, that his DNA
51 coming back as a positive match on the Mihelich girl's shirt could be another example of those guys
52 (Busch & Greene) continuing to victimize you even though they are dead. Sgt. Holloway explained

1 that the Detectives involved in this investigation want to charge him (Gunnels) with Murder and that
2 he (Gunnels) needs to think about cooperating and telling his side of what he knows and/or his
3 involvement in the Child Killings. Gunnels asked Sgt. Holloway to call his sister Karen, explain the
4 situation to her because he doesn't do anything without talking to her. Sgt. Holloway agreed to talk
5 to his sister and the interview was terminated. *** (See Sgt. Gray's interview narrative report for
6 further details) ***
7

8 **3-27-09: *** (The Task Force talked with Gunnels sister Karen, at her home in Dillon,
9 Montana today) ***** The Task Force drove down to Dillon today and Sgt. Holloway & APA Moran
10 spoke with Gunnels sister Karen Zaspel and her husband Craig. They explained to the Zaspel's, the
11 situation with her brother Vince's DNA being found during a recent examination, on the shirt of the
12 third victim (Kristine Mihelich) and he (Vince) potentially being charged with murder. Sgt. Holloway
13 and APA Moran explained to the Zaspels that if Vince had any knowledge of the Child Killings it
14 would be in his best interest to talk to investigators. Mrs. Zaspel understood the severity of the
15 situation and agreed to call her brother to stress to him the importance of speaking with
16 investigators. *** (See Sgt. Holloway's interview narrative report for further details) ***
17

18 **3-27-09: *** (Vince Gunnels phone call from the county jail in Butte to his sister in Dillon) *****
19 Detectives made arrangements for Vince to call his sister from the "Silver-Bow" County Jail in Butte.
20 Calls from the jail are recorded. Sgt. Holloway contacted Mrs. Zaspel about this incoming call and
21 she agreed to accept it when Vince calls. Vince had approximately a 10-15 minute phone
22 conversation with his sister Karen. The Task Force then had an opportunity to listen to the recording
23 of their conversation. Vince began the conversation with his sister by explaining how and why he
24 was violated on his parole and that he was never missing he was only 10 minutes late for the shelter
25 curfew. He went into a long story about how he did not understand why anyone would be saying
26 that they couldn't find him a few days ago, when he was right around the corner at one of the
27 shelters and had been speaking with his parole officer. After several minutes, Mrs. Zaspel told
28 Vince, that Detective Holloway & the Prosecutor were out at the house today and explained that his
29 (Vince's) DNA was found on one of the victims shirts. After lengthy discussions about Vince
30 violating his parole and not talking to Detectives about the Child Killings unless he has an attorney
31 present, Zaspel said Vince your DNA was on one of the victims. Vince said, "I wasn't there when it
32 happened." That was an interesting statement for Vince to make to his sister. *** (See
33 transcripts of this recorded phone conversation for further details. Also 2 other
34 conversations with his sister after this.) ***
35

36 **3-28-09: *** (MDOC will be having Vince Gunnels transported back to Michigan) ***** Garry
37 Gray (MSP) has been working closely with Michigan Department of Corrections (MDOC) making
38 arrangements for Gunnels to be transported back to Michigan on his warrant for Parole Violations.
39 According to MDOC, it will take a couple of weeks to get Gunnels back to Michigan.
40

41 **3-30-09: *** (I identified Paul Gunnels today, Vince Gunnels younger brother) ***** I performed
42 a check through the Michigan LEIN Network and located Paul Michael Gunnels, white male, [REDACTED]
43 [REDACTED] His age would have made him 12-13 years old during the time of the Child Killings. Paul
44 Gunnels has an extensive Michigan criminal History for drugs, assaults, domestics & traffic offenses.
45 A check through the Lexis-Nexis database revealed a current address for Paul Gunnels in a trailer
46 park in Bozeman Montana. Gunnels social security number is [REDACTED] His address is [REDACTED]
47 [REDACTED] This address is located in Gallatin County. ***
48 (See Paul Gunnels File for details) ***
49

50 **4-2-09: *** (Vince Gunnels had his parole "on-site" hearing in Montana today) ***** Garry Gray
(MSP) spoke with Gunnels Parole Officer in Montana (Ted Bury) who stated that Gunnels had his
51 hearing, entered "True" with explanations on all of his violations. Once Montana parole completes

1 their summary write-up of this hearing, it will be sent to the Montana Interstate Office for Processing.
2 Garry said that Michigan would then prepare the necessary paperwork at that time to have Gunnels
3 shipped back. Garry stated he believed that, based on this information, it could take several more
4 weeks to get Gunnels back to Michigan.
5

6 **4-3-09: *** (Waiting on Gunnels to return to Michigan and for the MSP Lab in Northville to
7 compare the fibers from Busch's home to the fibers from the victims clothing. We are also
8 waiting for the FBI Lab in Quantico, Virginia to compare the animal hairs found in the Busch's
9 home, to the white/tan animal (dog) hairs found on the victims clothing. New human hairs
10 found by MSP Lab Scientist Lori Bruski, will also be sent to the FBI Lab in Quantico for
11 processing Mitochondrial DNA processing) *****

12
13 **4-7-09: Garry Gray (MSP) is meeting today with MSP Lab Scientist, Lori Bruski to get a time-line
14 on the processing of the fiber evidence and the shipping of the animal & human hairs to the FBI Lab.**

15
16 **4-7-09: *** (I identified a new address for Kenneth Bowman (Adams) today.) *** His probation
17 was transferred to the Genesee/Flint probation office and Bowman shows a new reporting address
18 of [REDACTED] We are going to re-interview Bowman and the other
19 boys from Flint that new Vince Gunnels, including Brent Busch & Jeff Plumley to see if they
20 can put Gunnels in the Detroit metro area in 1976-77. Gunnels had told us that he never left
21 Flint, was never in Birmingham or the Detroit area and was never at Busch's house in
22 Birmingham at the time of the Child Killings. It looks like Bowman was arrested since we last
23 interviewed him. His Michigan Criminal History shows an arrest in River Rouge on 8-19-2008 for a
24 misdemeanor liquor offense and obstructing.**

25
26 **4-8-09: I drove to Bowman's address today [REDACTED] in Flint. [REDACTED]
27 [REDACTED]. In the driveway of [REDACTED] was a dark
28 blue full size Chevrolet Express van with gold striping on it. The van had Michigan personalized
29 license plate number [REDACTED]. This vehicle is registered to a Melissa Rene Keen a [REDACTED]
30 [REDACTED]. Keen is nil LEIN, record clear in S.O.S. The house is a yellow ranch on the
31 north side of Woodlawn 1/8 mile west of Belsay Rd. I knocked and there was no answer at the door.
32 When I returned to Livonia I called and identified Bowman's probation officer, Vicshawn Rambus at
33 [REDACTED] called and left a message for him to call me about speaking with Bowman.**

34
35 **4-8-09: Garry Gray e-mailed me stating that he had the search warrant for Busch's home re-sealed
36 at the 48th Dist Court today, by Judge Kimberly Small. The warrant will be sealed until June 4th,
37 2009 when it will have to be re-sealed again.**

38
39 **4-9-09: Bowman's probation officer (Vicshawn Rambus) called me back and left Bowman's
40 information on my answering machine. He stated that Kenneth is living in the basement of his aunt
41 [REDACTED] home at [REDACTED]. The full size dark blue Express van in the
42 driveway at that address came back registered to her. Rambus stated that Bowman's contact
43 phone number at the Woodlawn address is [REDACTED]. Rambus also stated that Bowman's
44 mother [REDACTED] lives at [REDACTED] in a mobile home park and is in poor
45 health right now. Her phone number in Belleville is [REDACTED] (See Bowman file for LEIN work)**

46
47 **4-14-09: I met with Garry today and we discussed upcoming strategies on this case. Garry spoke
48 with Cheryl Lozen at the MSP Northville lab while I was there. Lozen stated that she believes fellow
49 scientist Lori Bruski has shipped the new human hairs along with all animal hairs to the FBI Lab in
50 Quantico, Virginia for processing & comparisons. Lozen also stated that she (Lozen) is now ready
51 to begin comparisons of the fibers from Busch's home to the fibers from the victims clothing. Lozen**

does this ever happen?

1 is the scientist that will be conducting the fiber comparisons at the Northville MSP Lab. Gunnels
2 should be heading back to Michigan shortly on his parole violation.

4 **4-14-09: *** (All fingerprint evidence in the OCK case, including the partial fingerprint from
5 Kristine Mihelich's Parka has been sent from the MSP forensics lab in Lansing to the
6 Northville Lab for future comparisons) *** Gunnels fingerprints will be compared to this partial
7 print from Mihelich's parka.**

8
9 **4-14-09:** I called today and spoke with Bowman's [REDACTED] She is going to give Kenneth
10 my number and have him call me.

11
12 **4-16-09: *** (Phone interview with Kenneth Bowman today) ***** I spoke with Bowman today on
13 the phone about Vince Gunnels. Bowman had left a message for me stating he (Bowman) is going
14 by the name Kenneth Adams now. Bowman was real nervous right away during our conversation.
15 He began by telling me that he was worried after I left the message that it was about his DNA
16 coming back positive. I asked Bowman why he is so concerned about the DNA, to which he stated
17 that he knows he was running with Busch & Greene back then and that he (Bowman) doesn't want
18 to get railroaded into something he had nothing to do with. I asked Bowman if there is anything that
19 he didn't tell me during our first interviews back in 2008, to which he stated, "No." I told Bowman
20 that I wanted to talk to him about whether or not Vince Gunnels was ever down in the Detroit area or
21 at Chris Busch's house. I told Bowman that Gunnels made a statement that he was not only never
22 in the Detroit or Birmingham area, that he also never left Flint. Bowman said that he never saw or
23 knew of Gunnels being in the Detroit area or in Birmingham with Busch, but that Brent Busch,
24 Chris's nephew would know more about that. Bowman went on to say that the Gunnels boys were
25 close with Brent & Scott Busch and that they (Brent & Scott) would be the ones that might have seen
26 Gunnels in the Detroit area with Chris Busch back in 76-77.

28 **4-20-09:** I spoke with Garry Gray (MSP) today. We are going to have a Task Force meeting on
29 Wednesday 4-22-09 at 10:00am at the Metro North Post, to discuss our upcoming strategies with
30 Gunnels, Hastings, Brent Busch, Dyer and the Investigative Subpoena on Larry Wasser, to "wrap-
31 up" what we can do on this lead and close the OCK case, while we are waiting for the lab results
32 on the physical evidence from the search of Busch's home in Bloomfield Twp.

34 **4-20-09: *** (2nd phone interview of Kenneth Bowman about the Gunnels boys connections
35 to Busch & Greene) ***** I spoke with Bowman again today on the phone to ask him a few more
36 questions about Vince & younger brother Paul Gunnels. I asked Bowman about Paul Gunnels
37 being around Busch & Greene back in the 70's and being with Vince. Bowman said that as far as he
38 can remember, Paul went everywhere that Vince went. Bowman said that he thought that Paul went
39 with Vince along with Brent & Scott Busch up to the Busch cottage on Ess Lake. Bowman said that
40 Vince & Paul Gunnels were always with Brent & Scott Busch.

42 **4-21-09: *** (I went to Flint PD today and got Vince Gunnels mug-shot photo from 1980.
43 Vince was 18 years old at the time of this mug-shot at Flint PD) *****

45 **4-22-09: *** (Task Force Meeting today at MSP Metro North Post) ***** Present at the meeting
46 were the following: D/Sgt. Williams (Livonia PD), D/Sgt's Gray & Robertson (MSP), Special Agent's
47 John Ouelett & Sean Callaghan (FBI) and A.P.A. Rob Moran (Wayne County Prosecutors Office).
48 Garry Gray had talked with MSP Lab Scientist Cheryl Lozen, she said that she has begun the fiber
49 comparisons and would let us know about any positive results. MSP Lab Scientist, Lori Bruski, said
50 that she has not shipped the human hairs and animal hairs to the FBI in Quantico yet, due to how
51 time consuming it was, separating the human hairs from the slides containing animal hairs that were
52 recently located. Bruski did say that she would be shipping them shortly to Kary Oien (FBI Lab).

1 We discussed interviewing and swabbing Paul Gunnels for DNA. I am going to contact the Police in
2 Montana to assist us with that. We discussed interviewing Brent Busch further about Vince Gunnels
3 being in the Detroit area with Chris Busch and/or Greg Greene at the time of the killings. We are
4 also going to swab Brent for DNA and polygraph him on knowledge and participation. **Brent was**
5 **very close with Chris Busch in 1976-77, was orally & anally molested by him and told Garry &**
6 **I during an earlier interview that Chris would have Brent molest other young boys while Chris**
7 **would take pictures.**

8 Garry is going to talk to Lt. Hill to get approval, based on Moran's recommendation, that we travel
9 to Atlanta and interview and polygraph John Hastings in regards to his association to Chris Busch
10 and his (Hastings) possible involvement in the Child Killings.

11 We talked about bringing Larry Wasser in on his subpoena and having him testify under oath
12 about the polygraph he conducted on Chris Busch back in 1977. Based on the fact that Wasser ex-
13 polygraph partner, John Wojnarski told us that Wasser is a very meticulous records/files keeper and
14 that Wasser has kept every polygraph file he has ever done, Moran believes we may be able to get
15 a search warrant for Wasser's home or office for the records of his (Wassers) polygraph of Chris
16 Busch in 1977. Wojnarski's statement to us about Wasser keeping all of his files including old
17 polygraph files, is another contradictory statement Wasser made to us when he stated he doesn't
18 keep old files. Moran is going to research the possibility of a search warrant in this matter prior to us
19 bringing Wasser in on the subpoena.

20 We are still waiting on Gene Aldrich from MSP's Intelligence Unit in Lansing, who is working on
21 getting General Motors records of H. Lee. Busch's travel dates out of the country in 1976-77. Garry
22 talked to Gene and the request has been made through G.M. and he is just waiting for the results.

23 MSP is still attempting to locate the partial print and/or the photograph of the partial print from
24 Kristine Mihelichs parka, to compare to Vince Gunnels prints. Garry and I looked at the photo of this
25 print at the MSP Forensics Lab in Lansing back in March of 2008. Now they are unable to locate it
at the Lansing Lab.

28 **4-22-09: *** (I called Lt. Ed Lester in Montana about interviewing Paul Gunnels) ***** This
29 afternoon I called and spoke with Lt. Ed Lester from Butte-Silver Bow Police Department in Montana
30 today. He is going to have a Detective friend of his on Bozeman PD interview Vince Gunnels
31 younger brother Paul Gunnels for us and swab him for DNA. Lt. Lester said that as soon as I can
32 send him an e-mail with all the info for the interview in it, he will forward it to the Bozeman Detective.
33 Lt. Lester is also working on getting us a copy of the jail phone call between Vince Gunnels and his
34 sister Karen when the Task Force was in Butte, Montana in March.

36 **4-22-09: *** (Vince Gunnels was shipped back to Michigan today on his parole violations) *****

38 **4-23-09:** I spoke with Lt. Lester today. He said he has two recent phone conversations recorded
39 between Vince Gunnels and his sister Karen, and that Paul was making plans to come to Butte and
40 visit Vince before he gets shipped to Michigan, but Vince was shipped on 4-22-09, before Paul could
41 come to Butte to visit Vince. Lt. Lester is going to call Paul Gunnels and see if he is willing to come
42 to Butte from Bozeman to be interviewed, at which time Lt. Lester will swab him for DNA. Lt. Lester
43 also said that he is going to e-mail me the conversation between Vince and his sister Karen, while
44 we were in Montana in March, **and also the two recent conversations between Vince & Paul**
45 **Gunnels.** I will be able to download the conversations onto a CD for transcribing.

47 **4-23-09:** It appears through interviews with Bowman and other witnesses along with police
48 reports from 1976-77, that the Busch brothers (Brent & Scott) and the Gunneis brothers
49 (Vince & Paul) were the boys that were the closest with Chris Busch at the time of the child
50 killings, along with Kenneth Bowman. **All five boys lived in the same neighborhood in Flint**
51 **and also knew Greg Greene. Kenneth Bowman has been cooperative, although he worries**
52 **about DNA because of his close association to Busch & Greene. Vince Gunnels has been**

1 uncooperative and his DNA (Hair) matched a hair fragment found on the shirt of Kristine
2 Mihelich, found during the re-examination of the victims clothing in 2006. Brent Busch has
3 been cooperative, but we have not asked him YET, to take a polygraph or for DNA. Paul
4 Gunnels is about to be interviewed and swabbed for DNA by authorities in Montana and Scott
5 Lee Busch will also have to be interviewed.
6

7 4-24-09: I attempted to locate the Gunnels boys mother Monica in Lexis-Nexis and located
8 Monica Louise Gunnels born, [REDACTED]. She had resided on [REDACTED] in
9 Lansing, Michigan, Vince Gunnel's old address. I attempted to locate the Busch boys mother
10 Connie in Lexis-Nexis, and found that she is also deceased. Constance Jean Busch was
11 born, [REDACTED]. She was married to Chris Busch's older brother John
12 Busch, who is also deceased.
13

14 4-27-09: *** (Vince Gunnels is now back in Michigan at Jackson Prison) *** I spoke with
15 Garry Gray (MSP) today. He talked to Cheryl Deushane from Michigan Department of Corrections
16 who told him that Vince Gunnels is now back in Michigan from Montana and currently at Jackson
17 Prison.
18

19 4-28-09: *** (Animal hairs & Human hairs shipped to the FBI Lab in Quantico, via Fed-Ex
20 today) *** MSP Scientist Lori Bruski called Garry Gray (MSP) today and said that she shipped all
21 the animal hair evidence and human hair evidence to the FBI Lab in Quantico, Virginia today via
22 Fed-Ex. Lori explained that she separated & shipped all the animal hairs from the victims clothing,
23 along with numerous animal hairs collected during the search of the Busch home in October of
24 2008. Dr. Kary Oien at the FBI Lab will conduct comparisons of the animal hairs from Busch's home
25 to the animal hairs from the victims. Bruski advised that she instructed Dr. Oien to call her if any of
26 the animal hairs have similar characteristics, and those hairs will then be forwarded to a private lab
27 in California for DNA processing & comparison. Bruski will make arrangements at that time with Dr.
28 Joy Halverson at the lab in California to process and compare the similar hairs for a DNA match.

29 Bruski also forwarded the new human hairs to Dr. Connie Fisher at the FBI Lab in Quantico for
30 DNA processing and comparisons. These human hairs were observed, by Lab Scientist Bruski,
31 inside the slides that contained animal hairs from the victims. Bruski separated the human hairs
32 from the animal hairs for Dr. Fisher to process at the FBI Lab.
33

34 4-28-09: I talked to APA Rob Moran today who told me that he spoke with Larry Wasser's attorney
35 James Fienberg, who was asking Moran about releasing his client (Wasser) from the Investigative
36 Subpoena from 2007. Moran told Fienberg that he was unable to do that right now because there is
37 a problem that he (Moran) wants to talk to Fienberg about pertaining to his client, Wasser. Fienberg
38 wanted to know what problem? Moran told Fienberg he would be giving him a call about it. I'm sure
39 Fienberg called Wasser right away. This brief conversation Moran had with Fienberg was
40 just enough information to get Wasser thinking and/or worried about what Investigators have
41 developed over the past year or so. It also, "laid the ground work," prior to bringing Wasser
42 in to question him under oath about his polygraph with Chris Busch in 1977.
43

44 4-29-09: *** (Met with Polygraph Examiner John Wojnarski) *** Garry & I, along with Dave,
45 met with Polygraph Examiner John Wojnarski (MSP Retired) to discuss his (Wojnarski's) old
46 polygraph partner, Larry Wasser. We (The Task Force) had discussed with A.P.A. Rob Moran, the
47 possibility of executing a search warrant at Larry Wasser's home for his old polygraph files,
48 specifically Chris Busch's file from 1977. Wojnarski had told us during an earlier interview that
49 Wasser had a number of large file cabinets in his basement containing old polygraph files back to
50 when Wasser began in 1972. Wojnarski had told Detectives that Wasser was a meticulous records
51 keeper, is a "pack-rat" sort of guy and doesn't get rid of anything. Patrick Coffey had told me in
52 2007, that when Wasser discussed Busch with him at the convention in 2006, he (Wasser) told

1 Coffey, when he comes to Michigan he would show him the person later identified as Chris Busch's
2 polygraph file. Wojnarski told Detectives today that the last time he was in Wasser's basement and
3 saw these files was approximately 1999 and that he has had little to no contact with Wasser since.
4 Wojnarski, knowing Wasser, stated that it would not surprise him if Wasser has moved the Busch
5 polygraph file since this all came to light in July of 2007.
6

7 **5-1-09:** Garry sent an e-mail to Gene Aldrich at the MSP Intelligence Unit in Lansing to see what
8 Gene found out about H. Lee Busch's employee records from General Motors. We are trying to
9 ascertain the files that will show when H. Lee Busch was out of the country on business in 1976-77.
10

11 **5-4-09:** We are still waiting to here from Detective Scott Rios at the MSP Newaygo Post in
12 Newaygo, Michigan. He is going to make contact with Brent Busch about us re-interviewing him
13 about Gunnels and Chris Busch. We are also planning to swab Brent for DNA.
14

15 **5-4-09:** Garry talked with Gene Aldrich this afternoon, who stated that he (Gene) is still working on
16 getting the General Motors employee records of Chris Busch's father, H. Lee Busch from 1976-77.
17

18 **5-6-09:** Detective Scott Rios from the Newaygo MSP Post called Garry today stating that he made
19 contact with Brent Busch who stated he would talk to us and supplied two phone numbers for us to
20 call him and set-up an interview.
21

22 **5-6-09:** Garry sent me an e-mail today that stated that Cheryl Lozen and 3 other Lab Scientists
23 from the Michigan State Police Lab in Northville are coming to the MSP Metro North Post on 5-7-09
24 to go thru all the files to attempt to locate the partial fingerprint and fingerprint evidence from the
25 case, along with files they will need for future reference.
26

27 **5-7-09:** APA Rob Moran called me this morning and stated that Larry Wasser's attorney, James
28 Fienberg was at the prosecutor's office wanting to talk with Rob about Wasser's situation under our
29 investigative subpoena. I advised Moran to tell Fienberg that investigators have uncovered a lot of
30 information since we last spoke with Wasser that leads investigators to believe that Wasser has
31 been less than cooperative in this investigation and that there are questions that need to be asked of
32 Wasser under oath. Also that based on what Wasser told investigators earlier about not
33 remembering pertinent information, but having a vivid memory of other events surrounding this case
34 from the 70's, along with what investigators have uncovered, investigators believe that Wasser has
35 not been completely honest about his information in this case.
36

37 **5-7-09:** I spoke with APA Moran later this afternoon about his meeting with Larry Wasser's
38 attorney. Moran stated that he explained the situation to Mr. Fienberg who felt that his client had
39 already cooperated with investigators. Moran explained that based on their investigation,
40 investigators believe that Mr. Wasser has not been completely cooperative and has not yet testified
41 about this information. Moran advised Mr. Fienberg that he would call him with a date for Mr.
42 Wasser to testify.
43

44 **5-8-09:** Garry e-mailed me today, that Gunnels was arraigned on his parole violation here in
45 Michigan on 5-1-09 and pled guilty to one count, "Failing to report." Gunnels pled not guilty to
46 moving residences without permission. MDOC offered him a plea bargain in which they would
47 dismiss the moving without permission and recommended a 6-month continuance. At this time,
48 Gunnel's parole has been revoked for 6 months. Gunnels accepted and signed the plea offer. The
49 plea will be placed on the formal record on 5-21-09. Gunnels, is still located at the Egler Center at
50 Jackson Prison.
51

1 5-8-09: *** (Interview of [REDACTED] *** [REDACTED] had called wanting to come in this
afternoon and talk to me about what he had overheard in regards to the OCCK case. [REDACTED] is the guy
that was in the next booth at the Big Boy Restaurant in Alpena in December of 1991, that overheard
4 the conversation between Helen Dagner & John Hastings when John was telling Dagner details
5 about his involvement in the Oakland County Child Killings. [REDACTED] in Alpena and
6 currently resides at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that he
7 has a master's degree and is currently employed as [REDACTED].

8 [REDACTED]
9 [REDACTED] stated that he sat behind Dagner & Hastings for quite along time that evening with a friend
10 of his named Jack, listening to Hastings give details about the killings and drawing maps for Dagner.
11 [REDACTED] said that he didn't know who either of those people were at that time. [REDACTED] told me that
12 he thought their conversation was so bizarre and thought they were talking about some murder
13 investigation from the news or a movie. He said he never dreamed at that time, that it may have
14 been something that Hastings was actually involved in. [REDACTED] said that Dagner was crying during
15 their conversation and he felt that she was really upset and hurt over what Hastings was telling her.
16 [REDACTED] told me that he knew they weren't talking about any murders or abductions around Alpena
17 because it would have been all over the news. He told me that he then heard Hastings mention
18 Troy. [REDACTED] told me he remembers thinking that he [REDACTED] lived in [REDACTED] at this time,
19 near Troy and there hadn't been any news about any abductions or murders of children at that time
20 (1991). [REDACTED] told me that it wasn't until 2004 when he was on the internet after the BTK Killings,
21 that he observed Helen Dagner's website and saw people talking about Hastings giving details
22 about the OCCK case and drawing maps for Helen Dagner at a Big Boy Restaurant in Alpena in
23 1991, that [REDACTED] realized what exactly he had overheard being discussed in the Alpena Big Boy that
24 night.

25 [REDACTED] then told me the following highlights of the things he remembers overhearing Hastings
telling Dagner that night in Alpena about the OCCK case:

1. "I gave the children a bath before I killed them."
2. He told Dagner he wanted to live with the children before he killed them.
3. He talked to Dagner about the victims as if he were friends of theirs, saying "Lucy in the sky with diamonds" in reference to a song that one of the kids liked.
4. Hastings said, "I played games and watched T.V. with the children in a room upstairs."

32 [REDACTED]
33 [REDACTED] took my card and is going to e-mail me any other information that he can remember
34 overhearing Hastings talking to Dagner about in 1991. [REDACTED] told me that he wished he would
35 have known 13 years earlier that what Hastings was talking about was a real crime with real victims
36 because he is sure he would have been able to supply more information. The interview was
37 terminated.

38 *** The Task Force is going to continue to investigate the possibility of Hastings being
39 connected or involved in the Child Killings until we can get to Atlanta, interview, polygraph
40 and either connect or clear him once and for all of knowledge and/or involvement in the
41 OCCK case. As of this date a possibility exists that Busch & Hastings were associates of
42 one another at the time of the Child Killings. ***

43
44 5-12-09: *** (2nd interview of Brent Busch in Newaygo, Michigan. Brent supplied more
45 information about Chris Busch) *** Garry Gray (MSP) & I had Brent Busch meet us at the
46 Michigan State Police Newaygo Post today so we could interview him further about his relationship
47 with Chris Busch & Greg Greene, and what he could tell us about Vince Gunnels association with
48 Busch & Greene. A lot of the information that Brent supplied to Detectives was information that he
49 had given during his first interview.

50 During this interview, Brent went into more detail about the Busch Family at the time of the Child
51 Killings, the Gunnels and more about Chris Busch & Greg Greene. Brent talked about how much
52 time he spent with his Uncle Chris and how many times Chris molested him. Brent stated that Chris

1 was molesting him between the ages of 12-15 years old, which would have been between 1975
2 through 1978, up until Chris Busch Committed suicide. Brent told Detectives that Chris molested
3 him approximately 20 times between those years and that these molestations took place at all of the
4 different houses that Chris or the Busch's were in possession of. Brent talked about staying and
5 being molested by Chris at the home in Birmingham, Alma, Sanford and the cottage on Ess Lake.
6 (See transcripts from recording of this interview for further details).
7

8 **5-13-09: *** (Task Force strategy meeting @ the Metro North Post) ***** Present at the meeting
9 today along with myself, was: D/Sgt's Gray & Robertson along with Sean Callaghan (FBI). We
10 discussed our desire to get Gunnels to talk to us, and the different approaches we could use to get
11 him to cooperate with our investigation, including having the Prosecutors Office authorize "Use
12 Immunity" in exchange for his cooperation. I ran this idea by APA Moran. He liked it, but wanted us
13 to further investigate this lead and attempt to talk to Gunnels again first before he considered any
14 type of immunity for Gunnels.
15

16 **5-19-09:** Garry & I are going to meet with D/Lt. Hill on Friday May 29th, at 1:00pm to discuss and
17 hopefully get approval for the upcoming trip to Atlanta to interview and polygraph John Hastings.
18

19 **5-26-09:** Garry & I went through the files and pulled out more police reports and documentation we
20 will need to put into the power point presentation for the Prosecutors on this lead. We are going to
21 present only facts and support everything with police reports and other official reports from the
22 1970's.
23

24 **5-27-09:** Sue Taylor came to the MSP Metro North Post today to assist us in putting together the
25 power point. She is from the MSP intelligence Unit in Lansing and specializes in power point
26 presentations. We continued to input and update the power point and are probably two-thirds of the
27 way through it. power point? What power point?!

28
29 **5-27-09:** S.A. Sean Callaghan (FBI) called "Al Serra Chevrolet" today in Flint. We wanted to see if
30 they have old sales records that might show the sale of the 1975 blue Chevy Vega hatchback with
31 white stripes to Chris Busch in 1976. Bowman told police about this car in 1977 and told me that he
32 knew Busch had purchased it at "Al Serra" in Flint. They had no records back that far and stated
33 that they only keep sales records back 5-10 years or so.
34

35 **5-27-09:** Garry Gray called Jackson prison today and made arrangements for Sean Callaghan
36 (FBI) and Dave Robertson (MSP) to go and attempt to get Vince Gunnels talking and cooperating
37 with the investigation. They are going to see where he stands with all of this and what his attitude is
38 toward the news we gave him in Montana about his DNA being on one of our victims.
39

40 **5-27-09:** We put a call into Trace Evidence Scientist Karry Oien at the FBI Lab today to have him
41 update us on his progress on processing the animal hairs we sent him from the search of Busch's
42 home.
43

44 **5-29-09:** Garry & I and Dave met with F/Lt. Hill at the MSP 2nd District HQ today and explained why
45 we need to travel out of state to interview John Hastings. The trip was approved by Hill who wanted
46 a write-up thru channels to get official approval from the MSP command in Lansing. According to Hill
47 he should be able to get us official approval to go. We spoke with Lab Scientist Cheryl Lozen while
48 we were at District HQ. She stated that she has put the processing of the fibers on-hold, just for a
49 short period of time while a handful of new lab employees are being trained. Her plan is to utilize
50 several of the new Scientist to assist her in processing and comparing the fibers from Busch's home
51 and stated that these new Scientist are aware of the case and excited about assisting her with this.
52

1 **5-29-09: *** (Located Busch's attorney from 1977, Keith Stark) ***** I performed a search
2 through the "Google" database and located an attorney that has been practicing in Michigan since
3 1969, named R. Keith Stark. This is most likely the attorney that was representing Chris Busch in
4 January of 1977 when he was polygraphed by the state police examiner Cabot at the MSP Flint Post
5 in January of 1977. Stark shows a current address of [REDACTED]
6 Michigan [REDACTED]. The phone number is [REDACTED].
7

8 **6-2-09:** Garry called me today after hearing back from the FBI Lab Scientist Karry Oien. Oien said
9 that they have in-fact received the animal and human hairs and that they are currently in their
10 "Evidence Control Unit." From there they will be officially assigned to Oien to process the animal
11 hair and Connie Fisher to process the human hairs that had been found on the slides. A timetable
12 for this process was not given. "Hopefully soon."
13

14 **6-3-09: *** (Interview of Vince Gunnels at Jackson Prison today) ***** SA Sean Callaghan (FBI)
15 & Dave Robertson (MSP) went to Jackson Prison today to make contact with Gunnels. We had not
16 spoken with him since he arrived back here from Montana, more than a month ago. We thought it
17 best if Sean & Dave go, because Gunnels hates Garry & I. The last conversation we had with
18 Gunnels was in Montana when we advised him of his DNA being on Kristine Mihelich's shirt, and he
19 stated he would talk to us, but not without an attorney.

20 Sean & Dave had a pretty good conversation with Gunnels stating that Vince was receptive and
21 listened to what they had to say. Sean explained to Vince the situation that he is in, including the
22 DNA evidence, stating that because he has been so uncooperative with investigators, that they have
23 not been able to clear him. Sean walked Gunnels through it, telling him that he (Vince) has
24 maintained from the beginning that he had nothing to do with the killings and doesn't know anything
25 about it, yet he has made investigators jump through hoops and then he admitted sabotaging the
26 polygraph. Sean that investigators then still held true to their word and let him parole to Montana.
27 Gunnels agreed and according to Sean, Gunnels is starting to see that he has created a lot of this
28 himself by being uncooperative. Gunnels mentioned that he wants an attorney. Sean explained
29 that he has not been charged with anything and that they cannot supply him with one. Sean also
30 explained that he can hire an attorney and have all the attorneys he wants, but that they are
31 probably going to advise him, that if he were not involved and do not have any knowledge of the
32 Child Killings, to simply cooperate with investigators so they can clear him. When they concluded
33 the interview, Gunnels was going to think about what was said and make some phone calls.
34

35 **6-4-09: *** (FBI Lab has begun analysis of hairs from Busch's home) ***** Garry Gray spoke
36 with MSP Lab Scientist Lori Bruski today. She stated that she talked on the phone with the FBI Lab
37 people in Quantico and that they have begun the analysis of the hairs we sent from Busch's home.
38 They told Bruski that the process would take a little bit of time, but that they are working on it. (This
39 is Great news).
40

41 **6-8-09:** I got an e-mail from Garry Gray (MSP) today, stating that Sue Taylor has been continuing to
42 work on the power point presentation on this lead, and that it is coming along very nicely.
43

44 **6-9-09:** I was looking through some old e-mails from a year ago that Helen Dagner had forwarded
45 me about a guy named John Quarton that was Debbie Ascrofts (Kristine Mihelich's mother)
46 boyfriend at the time of Kristine's abduction in Berkley in January of 1977. This Quarton was known
47 to hang out in the bar at Hartfields Bowling Alley where Kristine's mother, Debbie tended bar. I
48 know the Quarton name from Birmingham when I was a kid. They were a well-to-do family that had
49 a road and a lake named after them in the Birmingham/Bloomfield area. Quarton was a suspect at
50 the time of the killings and later cleared.

51 **This is interesting, especially knowing that Chris Busch used to frequent Hartfields, was**
52 **about the same age as John Quarton and from the same general neighborhood in**

1 Birmingham/Bloomfield. It is also interesting that there is information that Quarton was
2 possibly friends from the Birmingham/Bloomfield neighborhood with John Hastings, another
3 big suspect in the Child Killings. We are about to go interview and polygraph Hastings in
4 Atlanta about information that he is connected to Chris Busch and his possible involvement
5 in the killings. Quarton will have to be interviewed now about Chris Busch and John
6 Hastings and their possible link to each other.

7 First, Debbie Jarvis will have to be interviewed about whether she remembers a friend of
8 Quarton's at Hartfields named Chris Busch or if she just remembers Busch frequenting the
9 bar at Hartfields, and does she possibly know Hastings also?

10
11 6-10-09: I identified John Peter Quarton, [REDACTED]
12 This Lexis-Nexis check shows Quarton to have graduated from Northern Michigan University back in
13 1973 and practices as a Clinical Child Psychologist in Bingham Farms, Michigan at [REDACTED]
14 [REDACTED] Quarton showed an arrest in 1971 in Marquette County Michigan for Dangerous
15 Drugs. This is where Northern Michigan University is and would match the information about
16 attending and graduating from there in 1973.

17
18 6-10-09: I called and spoke with a Sgt. Steede at the Sheriff's Dept. who looked up the file for me.
19 He called me back a short time later and stated that the file on John Quarton had since been
20 destroyed, along with the booking photo of Quarton. I'd like to see a picture of Quarton from the
21 70's to see if there is any resemblance to the OCKK composites.

22
23 6-10-09: *** (Spoke with Kristine Mihelich's mother this evening. She said she not only
24 never dated John Quarton, but has never heard of him) *** I interviewed Debbie Jarvis tonight
25 on the phone and asked her about dating John Quarton at the time of Kristine's abduction. Not only
26 did Debbie say she wasn't dating Quarton, she said she's never heard of him. I described
27 Chris Busch to her and she stated that he did not sound familiar. She said he kind of sounds like the
28 owners son, a completely different name. First I told her his name was Chris and she did not
29 remember a guy like that. I then told her the heavy-set guy with the beard's name was Chris Busch
30 and he was about 26-27 years old in 1976-77. I told her that we interviewed a guy from Berkley
31 named Boldiszar that said that Chris Busch used to hang out at "Hartfields" at that time. She did not
32 recognize the name Chris Busch and said she didn't know the name Boldiszar either. Debbie added
33 that she worked upstairs at the bowling alley and didn't always see or know people that came to the
34 bar on the first floor. I had a chance to talk to her about our two dad's knowing each other and she
35 said she remembered her dad (Bob Bell) calling my dad the night Kristine disappeared and asking
36 my dad for help. Debbie told me that my dad came to talk to her at the bowling alley the next day. I
37 remember the night Kristine's grandpa (Bob Bell) called my dad for help.

38
39 6-11-09: I talked with Garry Gray (MSP) today who said he received recordings of 7 different phone
40 conversations Gunnels has had from prison since being back in Michigan. Garry was going to begin
41 listening to them today. Garry told me that Gunnels sister Karen Zaspel was on Gunnels visitor list
42 from the Ryan Facility when Gunnels was there back in May/June 2008. This was the time we were
43 negotiating with Gunnels to get him to take the polygraph. We were also talking with Karen Zaspel,
44 trying to get her to tell her brother to cooperate with us and take the polygraph so we could clear
45 him. She never indicated to any of us at that time that she was anywhere but Montana, where she
46 lives, and never said she was right here in Michigan where we could have met with her in person.

47
48 6-19-09: Cathy King called today, stating that she had made a call to the Oakland County
49 Prosecutors Office on behalf of her father Barry King, who wanted to be updated on the status of
50 current lead. According to Cathy, her dad is getting up there in years, has health issues, and would
51 like to know exactly what is happening on this lead. She said that her dad has seen the video of
52 [REDACTED]

1 John Walsh addressing the media about how pleased he and his wife were with the fact that the
2 detectives in Hollywood, Florida kept them in the loop and didn't keep them guessing.

3 Garry ending up talking with Mr. King and telling him that we are very encouraged with the
4 prospects of this lead, we now have physical evidence, and are getting very close to resolution.
5 Garry told Mr. King that we are mainly just waiting on results from the two labs that are processing
6 the evidence (hairs & fibers) from Busch's home at this time.
7

8 **6-20-09:** I talked to a retired Flint Officer today named Gary Sanford who is a personal friend of
9 mine. He had talked with fellow retired Flint Detective Tom Waldron about whether or not he
10 remembered Chris Busch & Greg Greene. Waldron was the Flint Juvenile Detective that Arrested
11 Greg Greene January 25th, 1977, when Greene told him that he knew who killed Mark Stebbins.
12 Waldron then contacted the Task Force and they worked together arresting Chris Busch and
13 interviewing Busch and Greene about the Child Killings. Gary Sanford told me that Waldron did in-
14 fact remember the case and Sanford gave me Waldron's home number: [REDACTED]
15

16 **6-22-09:** I talked with prosecutor Rob Moran today about Vince Gunnels. We were discussing the
17 possibility of offering "Use Immunity" to Gunnels in exchange for information about the child Killings.
18 Moran wants to wait on the pending lab results before doing so. We also discussed bringing Wasser
19 in on the Investigative Subpoena asap. Moran has been in contact with Fienberg so hopefully we
20 will be able to get Wasser in to the pros. Office in the next couple of weeks.
21

22 **6-22-09:** I identified "Woodrow Bruce Weeks" today. When we interviewed Gunnels the first time at
23 Camp Ojibway, he mentioned an associate of his named Woodrow Weeks that may have known
24 Busch & Greene back in Flint in the mid 1970's. Weeks, is identified as Weeks, Woodrow Bruce,
25 w/m, [REDACTED] currently serving life in prison in Muskegon, Michigan for murder. We may
26 want to talk with Weeks. The reason I identified Weeks is because when Busch & Greene were
27 cleared by a polygraph in 1977, there were two newspaper articles written about this. Both articles
28 talked about 3 Flint men being charged and a fourth being sought. We have only ever known about
29 Busch & Greene. I want to find out who the other two men were. Cooper is the only named
30 mentioned in the one state police report, but we are not sure if Cooper is even connected. I thought
31 maybe Woodrow Weeks might be one of these 4 men, but he was too young back then. Maybe
32 when I interview Waldron he will remember the other two names.
33

34 **6-23-09: *** (I spoke with Flint Detective, Tom Waldron today) ***** I called and spoke with Tom
35 Waldron today about Busch & Greene. I couldn't believe how vivid his memory was about Busch &
36 Greene and the investigation into these two back in January of 1977. Tom was encouraged about
37 our lead and agreed to meet with me and shed as much light as he could on these guys connection
38 to the child killings. Waldron told me that he never knew about a drawing of the Stebbins boy, and
39 ropes being found in Busch's home in Birmingham and that he had committed suicide in 1978. As
40 far as the other two adult men that were arrested with Busch & Greene, Waldron stated that they
41 were just kind of "fringe" players that were arrested after all the interviews of victims in Flint took
42 place. Tom said he could not say for sure that these other two adult men even knew Busch and/or
43 Greene.
44

45 **6-24-09:** I searched through the tip files for any tips on the name "Weeks," and found a tip on a
46 Weeks, Lee Phillip at [REDACTED] I remember that Bowman told the Flint
47 Detectives in 1977, that Greene had a friend or relative that lived in Ferndale, and thought the
48 Week's in Ferndale could be Busch & Greene's connect through the "Weeks" in Flint. Garry Gray
49 (MSP) pulled this tip on "Weeks" and stated that he didn't think this Lee Weeks in the tip was
50 connected with Woodrow Weeks in Flint. It does not appear that they are connected, but could be
distant relatives.

1 6-24-09: I called Kenneth Bowman today to interview him about Woodrow Weeks. Kenneth told
2 me that Woodrow Weeks is in prison for murder, stating that he committed one murder in Flint, was
3 acquitted, and then put a rifle to the back of his brother-in-laws head and killed him, stating that this is
4 the murder Weeks is now doing "Life" on. He said that Weeks was very close with the Gunnels
5 boys and probably knew Brent Busch, but Bowman couldn't say for sure. Bowman also could not
6 confirm if Weeks knew Busch & Greene in Flint back in the day, but stated he probably did, because
7 of his connection with Gunnels. Kenneth told me to call a woman named [REDACTED]
8 [REDACTED] that used to live near Weeks & Gunnels in Flint and told Kenneth recently that she
9 thought that Gunnels had killed somebody years back.

10
11 6-25-09: I spoke with [REDACTED] on the phone today about Vince Gunnels. She stated that
12 Gunnels was in the same grade she was in at Cody Elementary School in Flint back in the 60's and
13 that Gunnels was a mean/violent person. She told me that Gunnels would torture her and throw
14 rocks at her, stating that in the 6th grade, he threatened to kill her. She said that she is still scared to
15 death of him and called him a sociopath. She stated that although she has no evidence that
16 Gunnels ever killed anyone, she would not put it past him to have done so.

17
18 6-25-09: I performed some searches through the Lexis-Nexis database for the Weeks family in
19 Flint and the Weeks family in Ferndale, which included relatives for both. I saw no common relatives
20 listed. It appears as if there is no connection between the two, but I have not confirmed that yet.
21 There was something strange in the relatives listings section for Lee Weeks in Ferndale. There was
22 a [REDACTED] listed as a relative, that lived on the next street from Weeks in Ferndale. This
23 [REDACTED] lived on Flowerdale in Ferndale. I called an informant of mine that knew Lawson
24 back in the 70's named Faye Goley. She told me that [REDACTED] is the mother of the
25 [REDACTED] that Lamborgine and Lawson had molested in the mid 1970's. [REDACTED]
26 testified against Lawson & Lamborgine at their CSC trials in the spring of 2007.

27
28 6-30-09: *** (Interview of Detective Tom Waldron Flint PD) *** I went to interview Tom Waldron
29 today about Busch & Greene back in 1977. Garry Gray (MSP) went along and took the notes.
30 Waldron remembered the case involving Chris Busch & Greg Greene very well and said he and
31 others were "flattened" when Cabot passed them on the polygraph in regards to the OCCK case.
32 Waldron said, "He couldn't believe it, and said he and the others all thought for sure they were the
33 guys involved in the child killings." Waldron said that he remembers that Deputy Oakland County
34 Prosecutor Dick Thompson came up to Flint in a snowstorm that day. Waldron added that
35 Thompson was a "Big-wig" in Oakland County and would not have come up there if they didn't think
36 they had the killers.

37 I asked Waldron what he thought when I told him that Busch & Greene should not have passed
38 the polygraph? Waldron was shaken by this, hung his head and said, "This should have been
39 solved 32 years ago." He stated that Busch & Greene met each other in a bar in Oakland County,
40 which would have been early in 1976, stating further that this is when they probably discussed their
41 common interests in children. Waldron told us that Busch and Greene were into exchanging kids
42 and would meet at a gravel pit in Holly, Michigan (Northern Oakland County) to swap the kids. He
43 said that Greene would bring a boy from Flint and Busch would bring one from who knows where.
44 Waldron said that this gravel pit is in the same area in Holly that they brought Bowman when they
45 molested him, in-fact, Bowman was the one that pointed out the gravel pit to Waldron. Waldron told
46 us that Bowman was a kid that Busch & Greene could really push around, stating that Greene had
47 choked Bowman to near death in the past when he wasn't cooperating.

48 Waldron started talking about when he and a couple other Detectives drove to Alma to arrest
49 Chris Busch. Waldron talked about Busch owning and operating a restaurant in Alma that was
50 purchased by his father (H. Lee Busch). He said that after they arrested Busch, they searched his
51 house and found ropes, shotguns, marijuana, and a suitcase with child pornography. Waldron
described the pornography as being 8-10, 8mm type homemade movies involving children having

1 sex in a tent in a wooded area. Waldron said that you could see the arm of an adult male in the
2 movie, directing the kids on what to do sexually, because they didn't know. He stated that this
3 suitcase also contained commercially produced child porn magazines, photos and movies. Waldron
4 said that this property was all confiscated and brought to the Flint Police Department, as part of their
5 case. He went on to say that he remembers at some point in February or March of 1977, the FBI
6 came and picked up the suitcase of pornography to analyze the victims involved.

7 Greene told Waldron where he hid a pack of pictures in his backyard on Baldwin in Flint. Greene
8 said that he wrapped the pack of pornographic Polaroid pictures of kids in tin-foil and hid them under
9 the snow near the downspout in the rear yard. Waldron said that he went to Greene's house on
10 Baldwin, dug through the ice and snow near the downspout and located the pack of pictures.
11 Waldron told us that as far as he can remember these pictures were never given to the OCCK task
12 force for comparison, because Busch & Greene had been cleared by MSP's polygraph. Waldron
13 said that he thinks this pack of pictures was put on evidence at Flint PD. Waldron went on to say
14 that if we call Gary Afford with the cold case squad at the Genesee County Prosecutors Office, he
15 might be able to help us locate these pictures. Afford is a former Flint PD Detective.

16 I asked Waldron if he remembers who the other two Flint men were that were mentioned back in
17 1977 in the newspaper article that talked about 4 Flint men being arrested in a sex-ring, 2 of which
18 were Busch & Greene. Waldron, without hesitating stated, Douglas Eugene Bennett & Hiram "Red"
19 Becker. Waldron said that of the two, Bennett was the one that was close with Busch & Greene.
20 Waldron stated that Becker was picked up later, was quite a bit older and not really connected with
21 the others, stating that Becker was in jail in Pennsylvania at that time. Waldron described Bennett
22 as being a white male that lived in Flint in the 70's and was probably born in the mid 1950's.
23 Waldron described Becker as also being a white male that resided in Flint on the 1970's, drove a
24 cab, had red hair, and would be in his 60's-70's today. Waldron stated that Bennett went to prison
25 on Flint PD's charges in 1977, for several years.

26
27 **6-30-09: *** (Identified Douglas Eugene Bennett today) ***** I ran a criminal history search today
28 for Douglas Bennett and found a Douglas Eugene Bennett, w/m, [REDACTED], to have a lengthy
29 criminal history out of Flint, Michigan and included an arrest for sexual assault in Flint 2-9-1977.
30 This would have been the arrest involving the Flint sex-ring mentioned in the paper in 1977. Bennett
31 also showed an arrest for Burglary on December 20th, 1976 in Flint. I ran a Lexis-Nexis search on
32 Bennett that showed him to currently reside at [REDACTED] and to be a
33 registered Sex-Offender at that address. I located a photo of Bennett from the Alabama Sex-
34 Offender Registry that showed that Bennett's victims of choice are 12 year-old white males, just like
35 the OCCK male victims. It appears from Lexis-Nexis, that Douglas Bennett lives in Russellville,
36 Alabama with his older brother Harold Nelson Bennett, white male, born [REDACTED]. It was
37 Douglas's brother Harold's 20th birthday on December 20th, 1976 when Douglas got arrested for
38 Burglary in Flint.

39
40 **7-6-09: *** (I got a mug-shot of Bennett and his arrest reports today from Flint PD) ***** I went
41 to Flint PD today and was able to get a copy of a mugshot of Douglas Bennett from an arrest of his
42 in Flint in 1975. Bennett would have been 17 years old in this picture, but looks older & taller for his
43 age. He could possibly match the composite photo from the King abduction, but I would like to see
44 his mugshot from June of 1977 when he went to prison. Garry called Jackson prison today and
45 ordered Bennett's 1977 mugshot.

46 I picked up copies of Flint PD's police reports from the arrests of Bennett for the Burglary in Flint,
47 December 20th, 1976 and the report from the child molestation arrest of Bennett on 2-9-1977. Busch
48 & Greene are not mentioned in either of these reports, and are not mentioned in any of the Flint
49 paperwork that I have seen. The 1977 newspaper articles talk about 4 Flint men arrested in a ring,
50 and Waldron said that Busch, Greene & Bennett knew each other, but there are no reports so far
51 that corroborate this. I need to go see Waldron again now that I have his old reports from Bennett's
52 arrests in Flint in the 70's, and see if he can clear this up.

1
2
3 7-9-09: Garry Gray (MSP) called and left me a message today, stating that the Georgia Bureau of
4 Investigation (GBI) talked with John Hastings. Hastings has agreed to meet and talk with us when
5 we come to Atlanta at the end of July hopefully.

6 7-13-09: We called and made arrangements today to go interview Gunnels in prison. They have
7 just recently moved Gunnels from Jackson Prison to the Gus Harrison Facility in Adrian, Michigan.
8 Garry & I listened to a recording of a phone conversation between Gunnels & his sister that took
9 place after Sean Callaghan & Dave Robertson talked with Gunnels a month or so ago.

10 In this conversation between Gunnels and his sister, it appears that Gunnels may be ready to talk
11 to investigators. He told his sister that he thinks he is going to be in prison forever if he does not
12 cooperate with our investigation into Busch & Greene.

13
14 7-14-09: I dropped off a packet of materials today for Waldron to look over and refresh his memory
15 about his investigation into Busch & Greene back in 1977. This packet included Waldron's old
16 police reports and some reports from 1976-78 that Waldron had never seen before. One of these
17 reports was the suicide of Christopher Busch, including scene photos.

18
19 7-16-09: Garry & I went to Lansing today and worked with Sue Taylor from the MSP Intelligence
20 Unit, on the power-point presentation on our lead. We finished it up until the point where the labs
21 are processing our physical evidence from Busch's home.

22
23 7-17-09: Garry received an e-mail today from the Inspector at Jackson prison whom we had
24 requested to locate a picture of Douglas Eugene Bennett from June of 1977, when Bennett was sent
25 to Jackson for Burglary. If the photo we received is in-fact the June 1977 photo (the date is hard to
26 read) then Bennett looks a lot like the composite of the subject seen during the King abduction.

27 7-20-09: We have been making arrangements to fly to Atlanta to interview and polygraph John
28 Hastings, along with driving to Alabama to interview and possibly polygraph Douglas Bennett. The
29 state police were denied any out of state travel at this time due to budget constraints, so it appears
30 that I'll be going along with Sean Callaghan (FBI). I briefed the Chief & Deputy Chief today on the
31 progress of this case and requested permission to travel out of state to conduct these interviews.

32
33 7-21-09: *** (Gunnels agreed today to take the polygraph) *** We went to Parr Highway
34 Correctional today in Adrian, Michigan and talked to Gunnels. Sean Callaghan (FBI) & I (Livonia
35 PD) and Dave Robertson (MSP) went there. Gunnels talked about being molested by Busch in
36 January of 1976 at Busch's cottage on Ess Lake (Documented in the Montmorency County reports).
37 Gunnels said that he and several other Flint boys drove up to Busch's cottage in Busch's Vega,
38 stating that they were pretty cramped in that car. Gunnels said that he was only molested by Busch
39 on two occasions. The first time was the trip he just described to Ess Lake and the second time was
40 in the summer of 1976 at Busch's house in Midland County (See Midland County reports and court
41 records that support this statement by Gunnels). Gunnels said that he was in Busch's Vega many
42 times, but was never molested in it.

43
44 Gunnels was told today, the 3 questions that we want to ask him on the polygraph and asked if he
45 would take it: 1. Did you participate in any way in the murder of Kristine Mihelich?
46 2. Did you have any physical contact with Kristine Mihelich's body?
47 3. Do you know for sure who killed Kristine Mihelich?

48
49 These are the 3 questions, and Gunnels agreed to answer these 3 questions on a polygraph.

50
51 7-27-09: *** (Hiram Becker identified and deceased as of 12-29-2000) *** I had identified
52 Hiram Becker a week or so ago as being Hiram Richard Becker, white male, [REDACTED], with an

1 arrest out of Flint Police Department 10-19-1978 for Sexual Assault. This subject also has red hair
2 and shows his place of birth to be Pennsylvania. This all matches how Tom Waldron described
3 Hiram Becker during the interview with Waldron. I performed a check on Becker thru the Lexis-
4 Nexis database and observed him to have died on [REDACTED]. It appears that he had been residing
5 in Birmingham, Alabama at the time of his death. Birmingham is only an hour from where Bennett is
6 living in Russellville, Alabama.

7
8 **7-29-09: *** ("Vince" Gunnels failed the polygraph today about involvement in the**
9 **abduction/murder of Kristine Mihelich) ***** Lt. Dykstra (MSP Polygraph Examiner) conducted the
10 polygraph test on Gunnels today. Before the test, Dykstra explained to Gunnels, what participation,
11 physical contact & knowledge all meant in regards to the 3 questions about Kristine Mihelich.
12 Gunnels stated he understood all of it. Gunnels then took the polygraph today without messing
13 around and attempting to sabotage the polygraph to get an inconclusive result like he did in October
14 of 2008. Gunnels failed today miserably about knowledge and/or involvement. **This is only the 2nd**
15 **failure of a polygraph in regards to the OCCK case, after hundreds of polygraphs over the**
16 **32/33 year history of this case.** Gunnels failed in regards to the 3 specific questions about
17 involvement/participation and knowledge of the abduction/murder of Kristine Mihelich. When
18 Polygraph Examiner Dykstra told Gunnels that he failed about his involvement in the murder of
19 Kristine Mihelich, Gunnels responded simply with, "Okay." While Dykstra was conducting the post-
20 polygraph interview and asking Gunnels about remembering Kristine Mihelich and having had
21 physical contact with her, Gunnels said that he didn't know her and that he has had a rough life and
22 pushed a lot of things to the back of his brain. Gunnels made another statement about information
23 could be in the back of his head, he doesn't know. Gunnels then added that, "A lot of crack has
24 gone through this brain since then." He then later added that he had nothing to do with it and
25 doesn't know that girl. **Gunnels failure of the polygraph corroborates his DNA being on the**
26 **shirt of Kristine Mihelich, bolsters the circumstantial case on Chris Busch, and explains why**
27 **Gunnels sabotaged the first polygraph in order to get an inconclusive. Vince Gunnels knew**
28 **he couldn't pass a polygraph in regards to the OCCK case because he has knowledge and/or**
29 **was involved. *** (See D/Sgt. Gray's (MSP) report for complete details) *****

30
31 **7-29-09:** I advised Prosecutor Rob Moran (Wayne County Prosecutors Office) today of the results
32 of Vince Gunnels Polygraph. He is going to meet with investigators next week about this.

33
34 **7-30-09:** Garry & I and Sean Callaghan booked our flights today for August 10th-12th, to interview
35 John Hastings in Atlanta and to interview Doug Bennett in Alabama.

36
37 **8-1-09:** We decided to re-interview Brent Busch about Gunnels and his uncle, along with
38 interviewing Scott Busch (Brent's younger brother), to try to put pressure on Gunnels to talk to us.
39 Garry left a phone message with Brent about wanting to interview he & his brother. This must have
40 struck a nerve with these Busch brothers. Garry received a call back from Brent Busch who
41 sounded real nervous, stating that his brother told him a couple of months ago that he (Scott) and
42 Chris Busch were driving around the Oakland County area back in 1977/78 and Chris pointed out a
43 location, stating to Scott that this is the exact location of one of the abductions in the OCCK case.
44 Garry spoke with Brent, set-up interview with Brent & Scott in Newaygo for Thursday August 6th,
45 2008 to discuss this further. ***** (See D/Sgt. Gray's report for further details of phone message**
46 **and conversations with Brent Busch)*****

47
48 **8-6-09: *** (Interview of Scott Busch & 3rd interview of older brother Brent Busch. Both Chris**
49 **Busch's nephews from Flint) ***** Garry Gray (MSP) & I made arrangements to interview Brent &
50 Scott Busch at the MSP Newaygo Post. During the interviews, Brent didn't add much significant
51 information from the 2 prior interviews except that we were able to determine that their dad (John
52 Busch, Chris's brother) knew about Chris molesting Brent prior to the dad allowing the younger

1 brother Scott to stay with Chris in Birmingham in the spring of 1977. Scott was ten years old at the
2 time he stayed with Chris in Birmingham and was molested by him.

3
4 During the interview of Scott Busch, he stated that sometime in the spring of 1977, after Tim King
5 had been abducted & killed he went to stay with his uncle Chris at their house in Birmingham. Scott
6 said that Chris's parents were gone and had been overseas for quite some time visiting Chris's
7 brother David in London. Scott told us that he asked his uncle Chris to show him where the King
8 boy was abducted from and that Chris drove him from his house to the parking lot at the rear of a
9 plaza type place where there were a couple of stores. Scott said that Chris did not say, "this is the
10 area the King boy was last seen at, or this is the store he was at." Scott told Detectives that Chris
11 pointed to a spot on the parking lot and said he was standing right over there (referring to the King
12 boy). Scott said that he thought it was strange the way Chris said it and pointed as if he was
13 speaking from memory. Scott stated that when he got older he thought even more how strange his
14 Uncle Chris's statement was. I asked Scott what they were driving that day that Chris took him to
15 the abduction site, to which Scott said Chris's Blazer. I asked Scott if the Blue Vega with the white
16 stripe was at the house, to which he stated he didn't see it. I asked Scott if he ever saw the Vega
17 again, to which he stated he didn't remember seeing it again after that.

18 (That's interesting that Chris's parents were overseas and had been gone for sometime in
19 the spring of 1977, which may have been during the King abduction. The statement by Busch
20 at the abduction site is also interesting, along with the Vega not being around anymore.
21 From interviews it appeared that Chris usually had the Vega around the Detroit area and the
22 Blazer in Alma.)*****SEE TRANSCRIPTS OF THESE TWO INTERVIEWS FOR FURTHER
23 DETAILS.

24 8-10-09: *** (Interview of John Hastings in Atlanta, Georgia) *** Garry & I flew to Atlanta today
25 and interviewed John Hastings about his knowledge and/or involvement in the OCCK case.
26 Hastings had been interviewed in the past (1991) in regards to the OCCK case, but never in
27 connection with Busch, Greene, Gunnels...etc. Hastings polygraph in 1991 was only about the King
28 case, which Hastings passed, but has never been completely cleared in this case.

29 Hastings showed up today to the interview. Carrying a "coffee table" book under his arm called
30 "The Encyclopedia of Serial Killers." He told investigators that he is fascinated with these types of
31 cases, watches all the cold case type shows and stated that the OCCK case is his the book he
32 brought. During the interview, Hastings told investigators that he doesn't know Chris Busch or the
33 Busch family and has no idea what Helen Dagner was talking about when she told investigators that
34 Hastings had told her in the past that he had a good friend that committed suicide November 20th,
35 1978 (Chris Busch's suicide date). Hastings stated again that he didn't know Busch and that date
36 means nothing to him. Hastings went on to say that Dagner must have made that up to try to
37 connect him to Busch. Hastings was also shown pictures of Busch, Greene, Gunnels, Lamborgine
38 & Bowman, none of which he knew. Investigators asked Hastings to take a polygraph in regards to
39 knowledge and/or involvement in the overall OCCK case, stating that if he takes it and passes it he
40 can finally clear himself in the OCCK case once and for all. Hastings agreed to take the polygraph,
41 stating he wasn't involved and had no knowledge of it other than what he has read. I asked
42 Hastings about statements that he had made to Helen Dagner over several conversations in Alpena
43 in 1991 with her about his involvement in the OCCK case. Hastings didn't deny that he had met and
44 talked with Dagner about the case on several occasions, stating that she would buy him coffees &
45 lunch. Hastings said that Dagner blew his statements about the killings out of proportion. (These
46 statements about the killings, by Hastings, to Dagner had been overheard by an independent
47 witness [REDACTED] that D/Sgt. Williams interviewed in the spring of 2009. It appears
48 possibly that Hastings did in-fact make statements about the killings to string Dagner along
49 for free coffee & food and for Hastings own entertainment at that time. It's also possible that
50 Dagner then embellished these statements by Hastings.) **** Investigators are setting up
51 the polygraph for Hastings that will be administered by the Georgia Bureau of Investigation
(G.B.I.). **** See transcripts of interview for further details.

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2
3 **8-11-09: *** (Interview of Douglas Eugene Bennett in Russellville, Alabama) ***** Garry & I
4 drove from Atlanta, Ga. today to an hour northwest of Birmingham, Alabama to interview Douglas
5 Bennett about his knowledge and/or involvement in the OCCK case, in connection with Busch,
6 Greene & Gunnels. During the interview of Bennett, he stated that he knew who Chris Busch &
7 Greg Greene were from his arrest in Flint in 1977, but never talked to Busch, only saw his picture on
8 the news at that time, after he (Bennett) was arrested. Bennett said that he only ever talked to Greg
9 Greene in the Genesee County Jail after their arrests. I asked Bennett why the media reported his
10 connection with Busch & Greene as a sex ring in Flint, to which Bennett stated that He had molested
11 a kid in the past that Greene had also molested. Bennett said that the media blew that way out of
12 proportion and called it a sex ring. Bennett was very believable.

13 Bennett told investigators that he talked to Greene later at Jackson Prison and that Greene was
14 pissed off that he got "life in prison" in 1977 and Busch only got probation for the same offenses.

15 **8-31-09:** Garry Gray (MSP) spoke with the FBI scientist today (Karen Lowe) that is comparing our
16 animal hairs from Busch's house to the animal hairs from the clothing of our victims. She assured
17 Gray that she would be conducting the comparisons this week.
