PROGRESS REPORT DATED 8-31-73 Friday

We, Young and Baker continued this investigation and this information compiled was the result of a letter from a subject named: STEVEN DALE AHERN, 9022 Orion #2, Sepulveda, Cal.

This letter was postmarked 24 Aug 1973 and it contained information to the effect that this individual was a Homosexual, male prostitute and a model for Pornographic films. He went on to say that there was a larger organization in the city of Houston and that in the pornographic field this was a large operation with films, books and photos. This subject went on to say that he had been here in 1971 after running an add in the underground newspaper called The Advocate and he received a call from Houston and was brought to Houston with his fare paid and he states that while here that he found a large pornographic empire and the exploitation of young boys.. Ahern also said that while here he was photographed by a WM Named ROY AMES and then spent the night with Ames lover and this was a WM named CHARLES ANSON and he was about 20-23 yrs of age. He also said that the recent victims were photographed by Ames and he can ID one of the victims who appeared in the porno magazine " MORE THAN 7" #1. Also Ames in Houston is supposed to have an interest in BONANZA CO and most of these magazines feature boys from Houston. Ahern says that ROY AMES KNEW DEAN CORLL and used him to exploit young boys. AHERN mentioned several other books and a little more information and this is in the letter attached to this report.

Officers thought that this information should be checked out and a call was made to the LA PD and the CI division was contacted by the CI division her after we had discussed this with them and the LA PD knows of this AHERN and they mentioned that he a member of the NAZI PARTY and writes letters and some of the information he comes up with is good.

Vice division was contatted and Sgt. McMenemy worked as well as Dale Bugger and the following list of books were found and purchased and will be attached and several more are being sought by the LA PD and will be sent as soon as possible, the books that we have now are:

Officers obtained a partial list of the victims and in HOT RODS #3 on the second page there was a photo that looked like WILLIAM LAWRENCE and the father was called and came to the office and said this was not his dead son and at this time officers still feel that there is a good possibility that it is the dead victims photo.

The subject AHERN was called and officer in Criminal Intell and Det Baker talked to him at length and he repeated what is contained in the letter and added some details and said that the book GAYBOY was published in Texas and he thought that this was in Brenham, Texas. And some of the books had a NY address where money was to be sent. Also he stated that when he was here in 1971 ...he was invited to a SM party at CORLLS apartment and he was asked by AMES and Coril. He added that he did not know where CORLLS apartment was but thought it was in Pasadena (THIS WAS BECAUSE THE PAPERS MENTIONED PASADENA,) Also Ahern stated that Ames took more than likely took about 30% of the porno photos in magazines around the county, and about 90% or so of the ones in this general area. He mentioned HOMO Heights on Westheimer.

Along with CI, information was sought on the subjects mentioned by Ahern and in the books these subjects are listed in the credits : JOSEPH P. ANTHONY, RAY HOUSTON, AND a record was found on AMES HPD # 134752 and also on CHARLES ANSON it was found that he was listed in the light cos records. Anson works for CLARITY MUSIC co and this is the same address as AMES home address and this is studio type apartment on Whitney st. It appears that all of these subjects are connected by more than queer type associations and are engaged in some business activity. CRIMINAL INTELLIGENCE HAS MORE DETAILED REPORT ON THESE SUBJECTS.

In studying the credits in these magazines, there is several subjects listed as officers ect and it was noted that an address was listed in Breham, PO BOX 1193, this was found to be listed to a Charlotte Griswold.

Young and Baker along with Sgt McMennay went to Breham, Texas and met with Sherriff Shulte and a check with the PO there showed that the Griswolds did have this PO BCX number and had gotten it on 3-28-72. The records were then checked on who had this box before that and it was found that a subject had signed for this box and used the name RAY HOUSTON. The box was using the business name of K AND R STUDIOS. This was taken out in 1970. The Houston subject listed his address as RT 3 BOX 399 Salem, Texas. This box number was checked on the tax records and it was found that two subjects had bought this property consisting of some 75 acres and they were listed as : KENNETH MAUL AND H. RAY GONZALES. The place is known as the K AND R ranch.

Sheriff Shulte took officers to the ranch and it is just outside Breham and off 3¹/₂ South 3.1 miles and it was found to be a very secluded area and when officers passed that location it was noticed that there were a small car, color blue parked by the house and 2 trucks and there was a large sign out by the road with ORGANTJE EGGS on it.

Nearby there were an elderly couple that were well known by Shulte and he took us there and they stated that at one time they had owned the property we were checking into and they had sold it to the Barkers who had kept it 10 years and then they had sold it and the two men living there now bought it in 1968 and almost a year later they had moved in and said they were from Cal and they tried to develope an egg ranch and this failed and this time there are just a few chickens there and the people have no idea as to how these subjects are supporting themselves. These people also noticed that the subjects want no one on the property and there is a large German Shepherd that sees to this. On one side of the property is a large field that is mowed and one side is a smaller field that it appears strange to the neighbors that it is not mowed and no one is allowed in this area and later in checking this is was found that there is a cattle guard and in driving though it was noticed that it has been used quite a bit and leads a cross the field and back though an

opening into the area by the barn of the K and R ranch. The neighbors noticed several other things such as when the subjects go to Houston in one of the trucks they do not leave the place un-attended but one of them stays all the time and lights are on till midnight or so and for the last several weeks there is another subject staying with them and RAY told them he was from Columbus and they then noticed that he drives ~~an~~ a car with cal plates. Officers found that these neighbors have been curious about these men and apparently have been kinda watching them and they mentioned that they knew RAY the best and he was a Spanish appearing young man and he is a GOOD PAINTER. Officers feel that RAY HOUSTON AND H. RAY GONZALES are the same.

Dets then went back to town and talked briefly to Milton Hriswold who now has the PO Bx that K and R did have and he stated that he received mail now and then for someone else and the last he remembered was from Arkansas and was to a studio and he thought it was the K and R studio or near that.

THIS PHASE OF THE INVESTIGATION HAS NOT LINKED CORLL TO THIS GROUP OF PEOPLE HERE IN HOUSTON AND BREHAM, TEXAS...but investigation will continue and if Corll was linked to them then this would explain where he might have been able to pick up some extra money.

It might be noted that JOSEPH P. ANTHONY owns several business places that are listed in the Gayboy book and CID is checking this out.

9-26-73 We, Young and Baker continued this investigation.

Mr. RTabor called from the city water dept and said that he had remembered an incident that happened several months ago and this was to the effect that he was on Knight road South of the Loop when he passed a white van truck and behind it were three white males and they had a pick and a shovel. Officers went to this location and met with Mr. Tabor and he pointed out the area and officers checked around and it was noted that a large amount of trash is dumped here by litter bearers and a small dirt road runs off at this location and the area is covered by bushes about 3-4' high. Nothing was found that pertains to this investigation at this time.

It might be noted that yesterday, Young went to High Island with DA Inv. BILL HUBBELL and Assistant DA, DON LAMBRIGHT and the location of the grave sites were found and more photos taken by Hubbell. Nothing more was done that date and this would have been 9-25-73. Mr. Lambright retained notes ect pertaining to this trip.

On August 8, 1973, Det. W. R. Young, Badge #D-324, submitted hair samples from Elmer Wayne Henley. On September 27, 1973, the undersigned obtained hair samples from the victim identified as Charles Cobble and from Dean Corll at the Harris County Morgue. On August 9, 1973, Officer N. R. LeBlanc submitted assorted clothing found in a plastic bag at 4500 Silverbell; Pasadena Police Department, submitted, among other articles, a wooden box, a pair of brown slacks, and an 18" synthetic phallus.

Examination of the hairs recovered from the clothing from 4500 Silverbell revealed several of them to have identical microscopic characteristics to those of Dean Corll and Elmer Henley. Examination of the hairs recovered from the artificial phallus revealed several of them to be microscopically identical to those of Elmer Henley. Hairs with identical microscopic characteristics to those of Charles Cobble were recovered from the box and the brown slacks submitted.

Hairs recovered from the evidence submitted will be retained in the laboratory for possible future comparison.

Mrs. Hudson (526-3954) who stated that she remembered (300 Units) Dean Corll because she noticed alot of young boys going and coming from his apt. (#33) located in Bldg. 2, and that she had gone to his apt. to tell him to curtail his activities and was met at the door by she believes David Brooks who asked if he could help her and she asked who his was and he told her he was Dean's brother she things and she asked him about a wire that was run from the patio to the door and he said Dean was an electrician and had a red light wired so that when the door is opened that the light comes on. She gave him Dean's message and she said they moved out in the night. The assistant mgr., Mrs. Jeter, who is now the mgr. at LaRochele Apts. at 6200 Westheimer, had seen then back & van up and carry out a roll of heavy plastic. She said they checked the apt. and found an artificial plant and a piece of plywood about the size of a door with six holes in it (on the corners and center) and the plywood was put in the storage bldg. We looked for this but did not find it. Mrs. Hudson was fearful of this information getting out and causing tenants to vacate their apts. and we assured her we would not make an issue out of it. She said there were only three persons living in bldg. 2 at this time and one family has moved to San Antonio and Mrs. Jeter to LaRochele. Also that there were only 120 units at this time. (1-16-71 to 2-2-71)

PRINCESSA APTS., 1855 Wirt Rd., #63, ph. ~~088~~ 467-2457 (Mgr. Mrs. Phillips and Mrs. Copeland. Mrs. Copeland stated that Corll's ph. number was 461-6290, that he had moved in on Jan. 20th and out on March 1st, 1973, and that he had rented furniture. She said that there was no one living on either side of apt. 63 that was living there when Corll was here.

POST OAK MANOR APTS., 11211 S. Post Oak, #75, 729-9811, Mgr. Mrs. Zitkus, 82 Units who stated that Corll moved in on the 5th of March, 1973, and out on the 18th; then a DALE F. SLOAN (WM) (27) works for "Rockwell Inc., which is located across from Place One Apts. on Mangum, moved in same day Dean moved out. After the story about Corll hit the papers, Sloan moved on the 15th of August. He has no record in ID. He indicated on his lease that he had previously lived at 5313 Navarro (which has not been checked, but we had an address of 5313 Judiway which was listed on a credit report of Corll's, and there is no such numbers on Judiway. FOLLOWUP INVESTIGATION 10-26-73

We Detectives Siebeneicher and Pierce had checked the address at 6116 Schuler at Washington on Tuesday, Oct. 23rd. We arrived about 2:10PM and learned that the owner, Mr. Ellis Rudy, was not in and his Secretary Mrs. Mark would not allow officers in the former quarters rented by Dean Corll nor answer any questions, stating that she preferred we direct our inquires to Mr. Rudy.

Mr. Rudy came to his place of business about 2:35PM and allowed officers to search the apt. upstairs. He accompanied officers on our search. Officers noted numerous holes in the walls which appeared to have been made with a drill, rather than bullet holes, because they lacked any characteristic 'grease ring' around the holes. Nothing significant was noted on our brief search of the area. We left the apt. at 3:40PM.

This address was again checked on Friday, 26th of Oct., along with the D.A. Investigator, Bill Hubell, on response to members of the grand jury having noticed a bulge in one of the upstairs rooms. This was checked and it appears that the bulge was consistent with the rest of the wall and the fact that the wall covering was not torn or separated far enough distance to allow the boards underneath to be pulled back in order to place any items behind same; The nails in the boards did not appear to have been pulled out & replaced either. There was a noticeable board along the west wall of the second bedroom from the front that was pulled out partially and upon pulling this board out enough to see behind same, it was found to have sheetrock underneath.

We also checked with the Westcott Towers and found Mr. Hubell had already checked the records for a tenant named 'Harmon' and told officers that none was found.

Officers checked the boat stalls ~~wat~~ on S. Post Oak and found the address to be between 11037 and 11040 S. Post Oak, in the rear. These stalls belong to a Mr. Frank Yosemite, of Rockport, Texas. Mr. Yosemite was working on one of the stalls and officers could see that the walls between the stalls were only chicken wire and would be less suitable for Corll. It was learned that the stalls referred to in page #38 of this report that a Mr. W.C. Dodd, has stalls #2 & 3 on the north side and that he stores instruments used in geological surveys in the stall in U.S. surplus ammo boxes. This was also reportedly checked out by A.T. & F. (Alcohol, Tobacco & Firearms). I contacted Mr. Dodd (667-1482) and he stated that this was checked by the P.B.I. and that he stores core samples in the boxes. Mr. Yosemite was given the names that Corll used to check against.

On interviewing Michael...he stated that right after the mass murder case broke, another homos exual named GARY WINTERS WM 18-19 had gone to galveston with KEITH (last name unknown) and a subject named CHICKEN JOE or JOE WILSON, WM 26, 5'9", drives a white van, is a pervert and Sadist, has a pistol and whips and chain in the Van. Wood claims that KEITH was tortured and killed by Joe Wilson and Gary got away and fled to Cal and just recently returned. Wood went on to say that the queers know that JOE WILSON is bad and has killed a number of Young boys after torture and mutilation and had ate a little of one and he meant chewed and swallowed.

The names of the subjects he mentioned to officers are as follows:

JOE WILSON WM 26.....pays for young WMs for homosexual activities and kills some of them.

JAMES KESSLER WM 17.....was room mate of WOOD and left him some 3 weeks ago. Now lives on West Alabama.

KEITH last name unk....WAS KILLED IN GALVESTON by Joe Wilson and Gary Winters got away.

Wood added that this information from him had been gotten from what he considered a good source. Both Dets Baker and Wucker received a phone call on or near the 1st of Feb from a female who stated that she lived in Jersey City New Jersey and that her name was Bonnie or Bonny and that she was closely acquainted with a Janet Blackman who had told her that a friend of Janets named Megiel knew or had run around with Corll and that he knew where 16 to 18 bodies were buried in the New York area. This information was given to Chief of Det's Sparr, Mineola, #4444 Nassau County, Long Island, New York, who is to keep us advised.

2-7-74

We received a wire from New Rochelle PD this date asking for information on a Eli Shomer who they stated they had in jail on a morals charge. I checked ID and Pasadena and they had no record on this name. I called New Rochelle PD and they stated that they had an informant who had told them that this Shomer had been transporting boys around the Country for Homosexual purposes and that he had brought some to Houston and they could be some of our unidentified bodies from our mass murder. They would keep us informed as to any other information they received and send us photos and fingerprints of their subject.
